Exam Guidelines for Students

- Students must check the mock exam timetable carefully. Dates and times of all their subjects must be noted.
- If sitting the first exam of the day, students must be in school as normal at 8.25am. If sitting a later exam, students must be in school no later than 15 minutes before the exam start time (for supervised study). Students may go home after the first exam if they do not have a later exam on the same day.
- Students must sign an attendance sheet at the beginning of each exam.
- Students are not permitted to leave the exam centre during the exam.
- Students must adhere to the seating plan for each exam centre they are in.
- Students should raise their hand if they wish to attract the attention of the exam supervisor for any reason.
- Students should not open their exam paper or begin writing until instructed to do so by the supervisor.
- Students must have all necessary equipment, i.e. pens, pencils, calculators etc. Sharing of stationary or materials is strictly prohibited. Pencil cases must be left in school bags, with only necessary items for each exam allowed on the desks.
- Students must switch their mobile phones and iPads off while in the exam centre. Smart watches must also be removed before exams. Such devices must be left in their school bags.
- School bags must be left in a designated area during each exam.
- Students must not communicate, or attempt to communicate, in any way, with another student within the centre or outside the centre.
- Students are expected to conduct themselves in line with exam conditions for the duration of the mock exams.
