1st Year and Transition Year Christmas Market

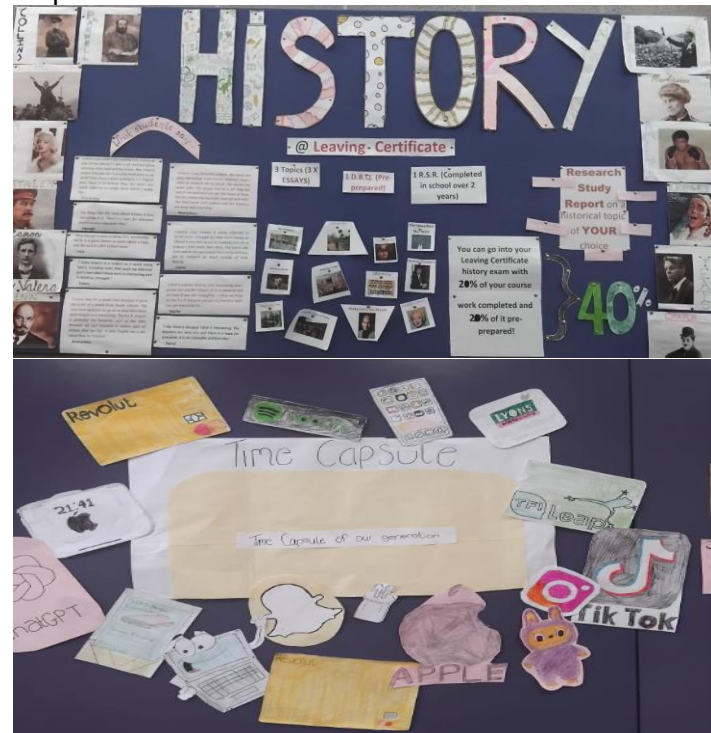

With a fantastic atmosphere, the displays were impressive, and the level of innovation and quality on show was exceptionally high.

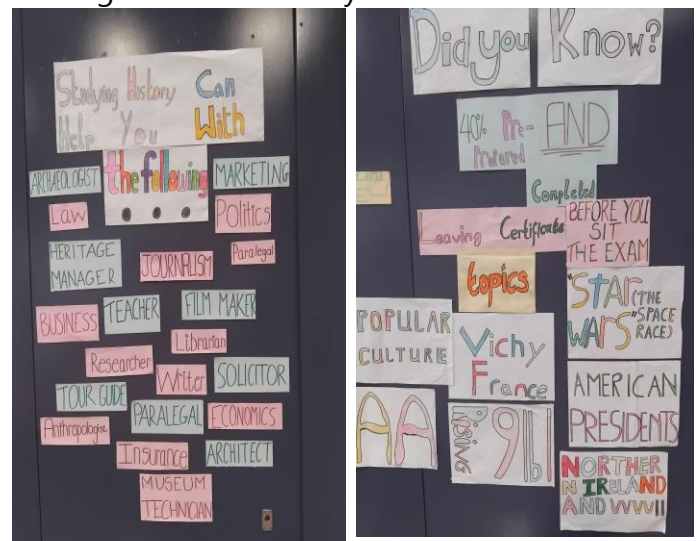


History Week
