- November 2025**
 - CAO online applications open on 5th November at 12:00 noon.
- February 2026**
 - Standard application closing date (€50) is 1st February at 5pm.
- March 2026**
 - Final date to amend course choices: 1st March at 5pm.
 - Most restricted-course tests and interviews take place throughout March and April.
 - DARE/HEAR online forms must be completed by 1st March at 5pm.
 - Late applications open 5th March at 12:00 noon.
 - DARE/HEAR supporting documents due by 10th March at 5pm.
- May 2026**
 - Late application deadline is 1st May at 5pm.
 - Free Change of Mind facility opens 5th May at 12:00 noon.
- June 2026**
 - Leaving Certificate examinations.
 - DARE and HEAR eligibility notifications issued (late June).
- July 2026**
 - Change of Mind closes 1st July at 5pm.
