What is it?

You'll learn about places, people, and the environment. You'll find out how the physical world (like weather, rivers, and mountains) affects people, and how people change and adapt to the world around them.



What will I learn?

Geography has three main parts:

1. Exploring the physical world - You'll:

- Learn how land, rivers, mountains, and weather are formed and change.
- See how events like earthquakes, storms, or volcanoes affect people.

2. Exploring how we interact with the physical world - You'll:

- Discover how people use, change, and depend on the environment.
- Learn how we prepare for things like storms, floods, or droughts.

3. Exploring people, places, and change - You'll:

- Learn how towns and cities grow and change.
- Study population, how people live around the world, and how countries develop.
