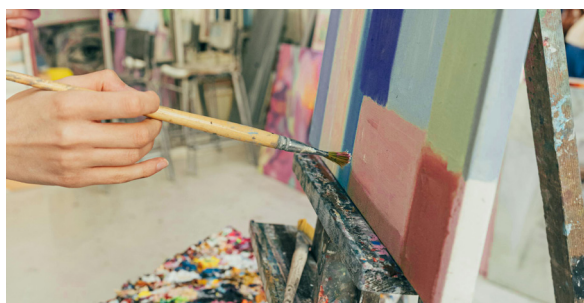




Visual Art in Junior Cycle

What will I learn?

Visual Art has three main parts:

1. Art - You'll:

- Create artwork by drawing, painting and using other materials.
- Look at and talk about famous art from around the world.

2. Craft - You'll:

- Make objects using clay, printmaking, weaving and other materials.
- Learn how tools and materials can be used in creative ways.

3. Design - You'll:

- Create designs that share a message or idea.
- Learn how design is used in things like posters, packaging, and buildings.
- Use drawing to explore and develop your ideas.
