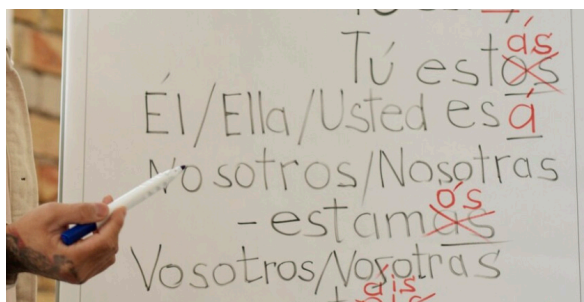




Modern foreign languages in Junior Cycle
