Quick Student/Parent Guide



Greystones Community College have adopted the use of secure signal blocking mobile PHONE LOCKERS in line with Circular 0045/2025 from Department of Education.

This approach is to support students in improving the learning environment by eliminating distractions.

Daily Procedure



- ✓ At the start of the day, students will turn their phone off and place it into their PHONE LOCKER before entering the school building.
- ✓ If a student chooses to leave their phone at home for the year, they can request a declaration form from their Year Head that states they have chosen to never carry a phone to school. This is signed by parent, student and year head and is carried by the student in the PHONE LOCKER.
- ✓ Students place their PHONE LOCKER on their desk during Skills 4 School classes.
- ✓ If a student forgets their PHONE LOCKER, they hand their phone into the office for the duration of the school day.



Breaches

- ✓ If a student chooses not to follow the daily procedures in relation to PHONE LOCKERS or tampers with them in any way, they will be suspended from school.
- ✓ Any phone not in a PHONE LOCKER will be confiscated and will need to be collected by a Parent.
- ✓ A student will have to purchase a replacement PHONE LOCKER if it is damaged, tampered with or defaced.
