- ✓ There is no restriction on how many liquids or gels you can bring in your carry-on luggage when departing from Dublin airport.
- ✓ Liquids in containers up to 2 litres are allowed through security at Dublin airport. The old 100ml limit no longer applies!

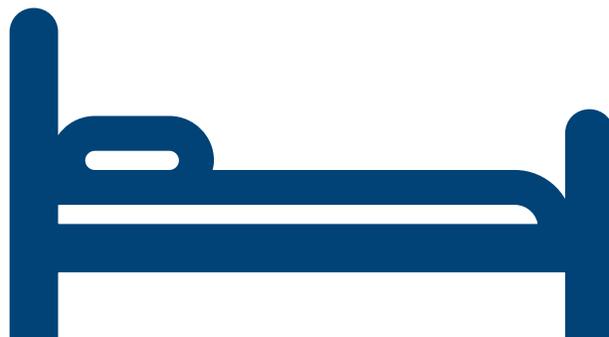

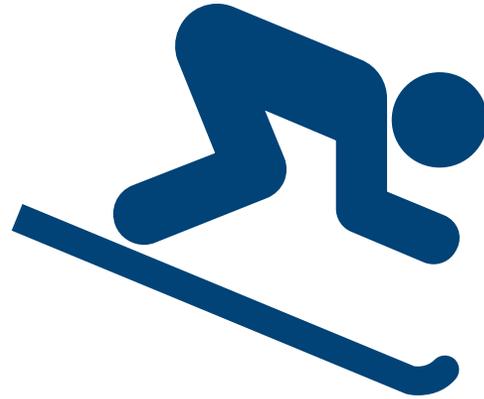

## Passport & Visa



**Irish Passport holders:** We recommend you have at least 3 months validity on your passport at the time of travel

**British passport holders:** Your passport must have been issued within the previous 10 years the day you enter the EU on condition that it is valid until the end of your stay plus an additional 3 months.

**Non-EU passport holders:** a Visa may be required to travel to your chosen destination and it is each individual's duty to ensure they have the necessary documents for travel.
