The **outdoor table tennis tables have now been purchased** using funds from the Colour Run and are ready for delivery.




Recent weather conditions have delayed the completion of groundworks but installation will commence very soon.

The sessions provided practical, age-appropriate guidance and were of great benefit in helping students navigate online spaces more safely and confidently.




SAVE THE DATE!
