Ní cheadófar an dalta isteach sa rang go dtí tús an céad ranga eile tar éis dóibh teacht isteach déanach (seachas le míniú ó bhéal ó thuismitheoir/chaomhnóir). Má bhíonn an dalta níos déanaí ná 8:55in go leanúnach glaofar isteach an tuismitheoir/caomhnóir chun é a mhíniú.
- (c) na leabhair agus fearas cuí a bheith ag gach dalta do gach ábhar – Corpoideachas san áireamh.
- (d) athrú go héadaí oiriúnacha spóirt ag an am cuí.
- (e) obair bhaile a dhéanamh a bheidh sásúil do na múinteoirí.
- (f) nóta mínithe ó thuismitheoir/chaomhnóir a thaispeáint don Oide Bliana, ar theacht ar ais tar éis bheith as láthair.
(N.B. Tá tinreamh sásúil ar leas an dalta. Ní mholtar saoire teaghlaigh i rith an téarma.)
- (g) siúl ar dheis ar an staighre agus sa phasáiste.
- (h) bruscar/ábhair athchúrsála a chur sna boscaí cuí atá sna seomraí, sa phasáiste agus sa chlós.
- (i) rothair a chur fé ghlas agus iad á bhfágáil an seastán rothar.
- (j) a chinntiú go bhfuil an dialann sínithe go seachtainiúil ag tuismitheoir/caomhnóir.
- (k) cloí leis na rialacha speisialta a bhaineann le h-úsáid fearas digiteach Gaelcholáiste Chiarraí.

4) Níl sé ceadaithe

- (a) cur isteach go fisiciúil nó go síceolaíoch ar aon dalta.
- (b) damáiste a dhéanamh do throscán ná do threalamh Ghaelcholáiste Chiarraí nó do throscán ná do threalamh aon bhall do phobal na scoile.

- (k) carr a n-úsáid le linn an lá scoile, am lóin agus am sosa san áireamh.
- (l) do dhaltaí obair nach leo féin í a chur isteach ná obair a cruthaíodh le húsáid AI (ach amháin nuair a dhéantar tagairt chúí di). Ní ghlacfar le haon obair nach léir gur leatsa féin í. D'fhéadfaí ort ceisteanna a fhreagairt chun a léiriú go dtuigeann tú an t-ábhar atá curtha isteach agat. Déileálfar le haon mhí-úsáid AI de réir Chód Iompair na Scoile, agus d'fhéadfadh smachtbhannaí a bheith i gceist

- Is don fhoireann amháin atá páirceáil i gclós na scoile.

Chomh luath is a tagann dalta ar scoile ní mór dóibh a bhfón a mhúchadh agus é a chur ina locair no ina mála scoile (níor chóir go mbeadh sé ar a gcorp).
Má fheictear dalta le fón in sheilbh (fiú ina póca) nó ag úsáid a fhóin i rith an lae, caithfidh an dalta an fón a thabhairt don mhúinteoir gan eisceacht. Beidh an fón ar fáil don tuismitheoir ag deireadh an lae scoile.
Má bristear an riail seo go rialta déileálfar le heachtraí sin de réir Chód Iompair na Scoile.

(d) Nóta as Tyro

Cruinniú aghaidh ar aghaidh ag Bord na Gaeilge le dalta agus tuismitheoir ag **-8 bpointe**

- Easpa dul chun cinn an dalta le plé
- Coinneáil tar éis scoile (Sampla: má tá 2 nóta agus nóta Labhairt na Gaeilge ag an dalta is coinneáil amháin é sin agus beidh coinneáil ar leith ann tar éis dóibh -8 a bhaint amach)

(e) Nóta as Tyro

This is an English translation of the Cód Iompair, Córas Smachta agus Riail Labhairt na Gaeilge

The pupil must understand that they reflect Gaelcholáiste Chiarraí's image while they are dressed in the school uniform.

Code of Behaviour

1) Gaeilge is the language of the school and its grounds.

2) Each pupil is obliged to have their school diary in every class.

3) Each pupil is required to:

- (a) be courteous and well behaved towards the staff and the other pupils.
- (b) students must be present by 8:55 each morning. The Students' Door will be closed, and students will not be allowed to their lockers after this time. Students will not be permitted into class until the beginning of the next lesson after they've signed in (except where a parent/guardian has spoken to a member of the school team giving an explanation). If your child is frequently late the parent/guardian will be asked to come into the school to offer an explanation.
- (c) have the books and necessary equipment for every subject, including sport.
- (d) change to suitable sports clothes at the appropriate time.
- (e) do homework to the satisfaction of the teachers.
- (f) furnish a note of explanation from a parent/guardian to the Year Head when returning after absence.
(**N.B.** Satisfactory attendance at school is in the pupil's interest.
A family holiday during term is not advisable.)
- (g) walk on the right-hand side of the stairs and corridor.
- (h) put litter/recyclable material in the appropriate bins in the classrooms, in the corridors and in the yard.
- (i) lock their bicycle on the bike stands on the school grounds.
- (j) ensure that a parent/guardian signs the school diary every week.
- (k) observe and abide by all of the school rules and policies.

4) Pupils are not allowed

- (a) to interfere physically or psychologically with any other pupil.
- (b) damage furniture or equipment in the College or those belonging to members of the school community.
- (c) eat, drink (except for water) or chew gum in classrooms.
- (d) have tobacco, vape or electronic cigarettes in their possession during the school day or during extra-curricular events.
- (e) have alcohol or illegal substances in his/her possession during the school day or during any extracurricular activity.
- (f) use lockers or be in the locker room except before 8.55 am, at break time, at lunchtime and after 4 pm (3:20 on shorter school day).
- (g) be in any classroom during lunchtime (except with the permission of the teacher in charge of that room).
- (h) go to the toilet between classes without permission.
- (i) leave the school between the hours below, save for when a parent/guardian signs them out and collects them from the School Office. The normal school day is from 9:00am – 3:55pm on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday and from 9:00am – 1:15pm on Wednesday.
- (j) use a mobile phone or other electronic device (except calculator) in Gaelcholáiste Chiarraí or on school activities, save where for educational purposes and under the direction of their teacher.
- (k) to use a car during the school day, lunchtime and break time included.

- (l) to submit work that is not their own or created using AI (save where referenced appropriately). Any work that is clearly not your own will not be accepted. You may be asked questions to demonstrate your understanding of the material you have submitted. Any misuse of AI will be dealt with in accordance with the School's Code of Behaviour, and sanctions may apply.

5) School Uniform and Appearance

The pupil must fully comply with Gaelcholáiste Chiarraí's School uniform Policy regarding (available in the school office and at www.gcchiarrai.ie)

Note: Pupils should not have large sums of money or valuables in school or in the Sports Centre. Gaelcholáiste Chiarraí will not accept responsibility for them.

- **CCTV cameras are recording throughout the school grounds.**
- **Parking on the school grounds is reserved for staff only.**

Discipline System

This will be a progressive system

- Stage 1**
- note on Tyro
 - discuss with pupil.

Stage 2 – The Class teacher will evaluate the student’s Tyro profile weekly and in consultation with the Year Head a penalty imposed

- Students will receive lunchtime detention where:
 - 3 x notes for behavioural issues/ Riail Labhairt na Gaeilge/unprepared/failing to present satisfactory h/w in a fortnight.
- \If a student is scheduled to do a lunchtime detention for the third, sixth, ninth, (continued) time they will do the detention afterschool instead.
- Afterschool detention applies where a student receives a note for being in the toilet cubicle with another student.
- Parents/guardians will be informed of lunchtime/afterschool detention via a note in the student’s Tyro profile

Stage 3 – Year Head (and Deputy Principal or Principal if required)

- a meeting (or phone call if appropriate) is arranged with the pupil and parent/guardian.
- pupil and parents/guardians are informed of penalty by means of Tyro.
- Plan of improved behaviour discussed.
- parents/guardians notified of prospect of suspension at next Stage (if appropriate).

Stage 4 – Year Head, Deputy Principal or Principal

- a meeting (or phone call if appropriate) is arranged with the pupil and parent/guardian,
- penalty – a period of suspension – parents/guardians informed of penalty by letter.

Stage 5 – Principal

- when it is clear that the pupil is disregarding the rules and the above code, it will be recommended to the Board of Management that the pupil be expelled.
- A letter will be sent to the parents/guardians of the pupil informing them of this recommendation and that they may appeal it to the Board.

Note: In serious cases it is not necessary to follow the above step-by-step system and the school leadership can proceed directly to steps 4 or 5:

- (a) When the rights of pupil(s) or member of Gaelcholáiste Chiarraí’s staff are gravely infringed.
- (b) in the event that there is a health and safety risk for students and or staff of the Gaelcholáiste.
- (c) in the event that a student breaks school rules relating to the use of, or possession of, tobacco/ nicotine products, vaping products or electronic cigarettes, alcohol or illegal substances.
- (d) When malicious damage is done to the school.

Penalty:

In the case of 2 and 3 above the following penalties as appropriate

- Detention at lunchtime and/or evening, with the student completing a reflective worksheet.
- Not allowed to take part in extra-curricular events.
- Internal suspension.

Mobile Phone - Rule 4) (j)

- Students are not permitted to use their phones during the school day. All students must, on entering school each morning, power off their phones and place it either in their locker or in their school bag (it is not to remain on their person). If a student is seen with a phone in their possession (even in a pocket) or using their phone during the day, they must hand the phone over to the teacher without exception. The phone will be available for collection by a parent at the end of the school day. Repeated incidents will be dealt with by means of the school Code of Behaviour. Students are not permitted to use their phones to pay in the canteen. Students may use a card or cash instead. If a parent needs to send an important message to their child during the school day, they should contact the school office and the message will be passed on. Otherwise, if you send a message directly, you should assume it will not be seen until the end of the school day.
From time to time, Transition Year students and senior students may be permitted to use their phones during class for a specific purpose, with prior permission from the class teacher. After use, the student must switch off the phone and return it to their school bag.

Gaeilge

Is í an Ghaeilge teanga chumarsáide Gaelcholáiste Chiarraí. Bímid ag súil leis go labhróidh na daltaí Gaeilge i gcónaí i dtimpeallacht na scoile agus ag ócáidí scoile.

If a student does not conform to Riail Labhairt na Gaeilge, the following stages will be followed:

(a) Note in the student's Tyro profile

A discussion will take place between the Class Teacher and the student at **-2 points**.

(b) Note in the student's Tyro profile

A discussion will take place between the Year Head and the student at **-4 points**.

- The student will be reminded that they might not be permitted on the class trip to the Gaeltacht (where appropriate) if they break the rule again.

(c) Note in the student's Tyro profile

The student must meet Bord na Gaeilge at **-6 points**.

- The Year Head will contact the parent(s)/Guardian(s)
- An improvement plan will be discussed
- A letter will be sent home by the Year Head explaining that if the next stage is reached the parent/guardian will be requested to attend a Bord na Gaeilge meeting

(d) Note in the student's Tyro profile

The student and their parent/guardian must meet Bord na Gaeilge at **-8 points**.

- The lack of progress will be discussed.
- Afterschool detention specifically for reaching -8 points. (e.g. if a student has 2 notes and a "Labhairt na Gaeilge" note, the combination of these 3 notes counts as one detention, and a separate detention will be issued for reaching -8)
- A letter will be sent home explaining that the student will have one day internal suspension if they break the rule again.

(e) Note in the student's Tyro profile

The Year Head will contact the parent(s)/Guardian(s) at **-10 points**.

- One day internal suspension.
- A letter will be sent home explaining that the student's disregard for the school Labhairt na Gaeilge rules will be discussed at the Board of Management and the student and their parent/guardian may be requested to attend the meeting to discuss same.

Relief for students of Bliain 1*

Riail Labhairt na Gaeilge will be applied to BL1 students as well as every other year group however:

1. A BL1 student will be dealt with at step (a) and step (b) of the above graduated system up to the first half term.
2. The record will begin anew after the October mid-term break.

*In cases where it is clear to the Year Head and the Principal that Riail Labhairt na Gaeilge is being ignored, it is not necessary to follow the *Relief for students of Bliain 1* above.

Note: Students that do not, in the opinion of Gaelcholáiste Chiarraí's management, display due regard to Riail Labhairt na Gaeilge may be excluded from participating in sports activities, class trips, tours or other extracurricular activities.

The school authorities must be satisfied in relation to the Irish Speaking Rule. The suitability of the school for students who continuously break the Irish Speaking Rule will be reviewed at the end of the school year.
