ART THERAPY CLONMEL BASED SERVICE

What is Art Therapy?

Art therapy aims to **improve mental health**, aid in **emotional well being** and build resilience. It is suitable for all ages and abilities. Art Therapy will be facilitated by Art Therapist Carmel Behan. Carmel trained at Munster Technological University (formerly CIT). Carmel is a member of IACAT- Irish Association of Creative Art Therapists.

How long is the Therapy?

Therapy sessions run for **50 minutes** and take place **once a week**, usually starting with a **12 week block**. The therapist will guide the client through the art making process and hold the space for them as they **explore their emotions**. Sessions are confidential and client led, meaning the client will decide what is brought up in therapy. Sessions will be **reviewed** after intro 4 sessions and then at week 12. These reviews will be arranged with the parents/ guardians where necessary so the best course of action for the child can be decided.

An initial consultation session with parent/guardians is necessary and will cover the layout of sessions, client history and expectations of the sessions. Art Therapy is €70 euro per session.
