

Reflecting on exam results

Students will receive results from their house exams and have their scripts returned to them soon. Some results might please the student while they may feel disappointed with others.

In both cases, it is very important for students to reflect on their experience and on their results. Consider the following:

- Why did you get this result? Consider what you did well in the build up to the exam and consider areas for improvement (did you do enough study? Was time spent studying used efficiently? etc.)
- What areas are you struggling with? This could be a particular area within a subject or the entire subject. Did you put the work in before the exam?
- Talk to your teachers. Your teachers might have some useful tips on how to improve your answers or on how to revise.
- Learn from your mistakes! Don't get caught out again making the same mistake in the next set of exams.
