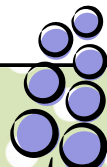
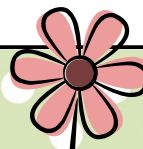
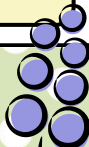
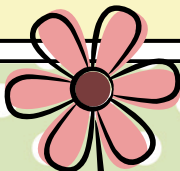
Mr Elwood's Class: These are some of the lovely penguins they made for art.

Room 7 Senior Infants

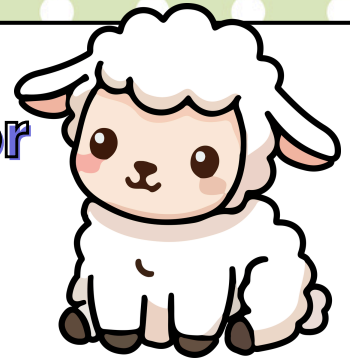

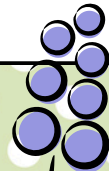
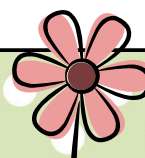
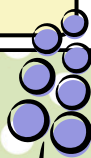
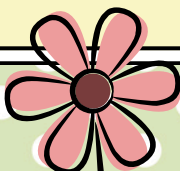
The experience gave them a better understanding and appreciation of teaching modern European languages as part of the new curriculum.

Cricket Blitz !

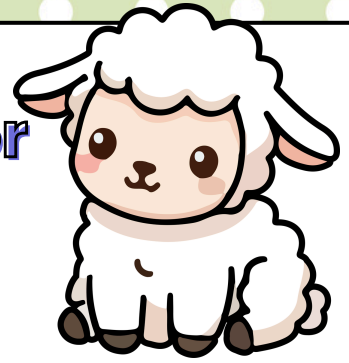

Na Gaeilge

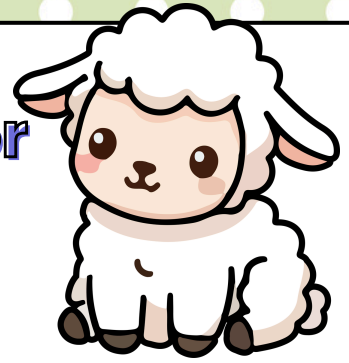

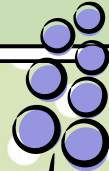
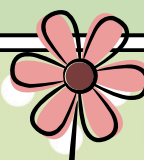

Our friends in Belgium

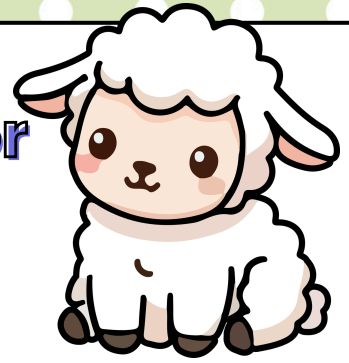


Two teachers from Belgium visited us on an Erasmus+ mobility last year, They sent us cards that their students had made, and some Belgian sweets.

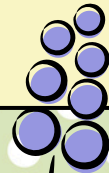
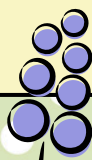
