# Supervised Evening Study Charter

To ensure a productive and respectful study environment for all, students are kindly asked to observe the following expectations:

1. Students can commence Evening Study once initial deposit has been paid.
2. Evening Study runs on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4pm to 6pm.
3. Please arrive on time, wear the correct school uniform, and sit at your assigned desk.
4. To maintain focus, students should refrain from communicating with others during study.
5. A sandwich and bottle of water will be provided to students at Evening Study.
6. To minimise disruption, students should arrive fully prepared with all necessary books and materials for the full duration of the session. We recommend using the toilet beforehand. A 10-minute break will be given halfway through Evening Study.
7. Electronic devices, including mobile phones, may only be used with prior permission from the Evening Study Supervising Teacher and only strictly for educational purposes.
8. If a student is unable to attend, a parent or guardian should inform the school.
9. For safety and supervision reasons, students must remain within the designated study area and are not permitted to study elsewhere on campus or leave the premises during Evening Study.
10. We ask all students to cooperate respectfully with the Supervising Teacher at all times.
11. Please note that repeated breaches of these guidelines may result in temporary or permanent removal from the study programme, at the discretion of the Principal. No refunds will be issued in such cases.
12. Grennan College's Code of Behaviour applies at all times during Evening Study.
