- Chun obair an lae a threisiú
- Chun nasc a chruthú idir scoil agus baile
- Chun aird pháistí a dhíriú agus scileanna eagrúcháin a fhorbairt agus foghlaim neamhspleách a spreagadh

Go Ginearálta

- Bítear ag súil go ndéanfaidh páistí an iarracht is fearr agus iad i mbun obair bhaile. Bíonn an obair bhaile bunaithe don chuid is mó ar obair atá ar eolas ag an bpáiste. 'Sna hardranganna d'fhéadfadh go mbeadh obair níos dúshlánaí i gceist agus obair chruthaíoch chomh maith.
- Tugtar obair bhaile ó Luan go Déardaoin don chuid is mó. Ní thugtar obair bhaile ag an deireadh seachtaine de ghnáth. Ní thugtar obair bhaile i Mí Meán Fómhair d'aon rang. Ní thugtar aon obair bhaile scríofa d'aon rang i Mí An Mheithimh. Leanfaidh an obair leis an léitheoireacht/fónaíca srl. go dtí, thart ar, an tseachtain deiridh sa scoilbhliain.
- D'fhéadfadh múinteoir nó an Príomhoide oíche saor ó obair bhaile a bhronnadh ar rang nó ar pháiste aonair le haitheantas a thabhairt ar ócáid, iarracht, obair dhearfach. Bronntar pasanna 'saor ó obair bhaile' ar pháistí chomh maith. Ní mór do pháiste a chinntiú leis an múinteoir ranga go bhfuil cead acu an pas a úsáid ar oíche ar bith agus a chinntiú cén obair bhaile go díreach gur feidir a ghlacadh saor.

Treoirínte

- Seo a leanas treoirínte maidir leis an saghas obair a bheadh á dhéanamh ag do pháiste don obair bhaile. Beidh páistí áirithe críochnaithe go han-tapaídh agus tógfaidh sé an-chuid ama ar pháistí eile an obair bhaile chéanna a chríochnú. Sa chás go mbíonn do pháiste ag caitheamh an-chuid ama ar an obair bhaile ba chóir iad a stopadh tar éis 20nóiméad de obair-dhian agus nóta a sheoladh chuig an múinteoir.

N1: Ní thugtar obair bhaile de ghnáth.

N2: Léamh/Cluichí foghraíochta/Fónaice amháin.

Rang 1: Béim ar léamh, cluichí fónaice sa Ghaeilge agus sa Bhéarla Píosa amháin scríbhneoireachta nó Mata i rith na seachtaine.

Rang 2 go Rang 6: Píosa scríbhneoireachta/Mata uair nó dhó sa tseachtain. Béim ar léamh, cluichí léitheoireachta sa Ghaeilge agus Béarla. Tionscanamh nó obair neamh-spleách ó am go ham.

- Tabhair faoi deara go mbíonn cothromaíocht idir obair scríofa, táblaí, léitheoireacht, litriú, ullmhúcháin agus foghlaim de ghlan mheabhair. Is minic nach leagann páistí an bhéim chéanna ar an léitheoireacht, ullmhúcháin agus ar an bhfoghlaim agus déantar neamhaird díobh. Tá siad chomh tábhachtach céanna is atá an obair scríofa agus cuireann siad leis an achar ama ó thaobh obair bhaile de.

Iarrtar ar thuismitheoirí

- Tacú le páistí agus iad i mbun an obair bhaile ach gan an obair bhaile a dhéanamh dóibh
- Teagmháil a dhéanamh le múinteoir má cheapann tú nach bhfuil ag éirí le do pháiste ó thaobh obair bhaile de.

Homework Policy

Homework is given

- To recap on the day's work
- To establish a link between home and school
- To develop a child's concentration skills and to encourage organisational skills and independent learning

Generally

- Children are expected to do their homework to the best of their ability. Homework is generally based on work with which the child is already familiar. In the senior classes the work may be more challenging and creative and research work may also be part of the homework.
- Homework is given from Monday to Thursday. Homework is not generally given on a weekend. Homework is not given to any class in September and no written homework is given to any class in June. It is expected that reading and phonics work continues until around the last week of the school year.
- A night off homework may be given at the discretion of a teacher or the principal in recognition of an occasion, effort or positive work. 'Saor ó obair bhaile' passes are also presented to children as a positive reward. A child should always consult with the class teacher prior to using a 'pas saor ó obair bhaile' to ensure what elements of homework may be passed on if any on a given night.

Guidelines

- Below are some guidelines in relation to what type of work your child would be asked to engage in for homework. Certain children will finish the homework in a shorter time and others will have difficulty finishing the same homework within a reasonable timeframe. Should your child be consistently spending more than 20mins full concentration on his/her written homework then they should be stopped and a note written for the teacher.

N1: No homework is generally given

N2: Sounds games, literacy games and reading practice only.


Rang 1: Emphasis on phonics and reading in Irish and English daily.
One piece of Maths/Written work during the week

Rang 2 go Rang 6: Written/Maths work once or twice weekly.
English/Irish reading daily.
Project work/Individual tasks from time to time

- Please note that homework can consist of written work, tables, reading, spellings, preparation and learning by heart. Children often tend to overlook reading, learning by heart and preparation and not emphasise them as much as written work and not spend as much time on them yet they are as important and contribute significantly to the time allocated for homework each evening.

Parents are requested

- To support their children while completing homework but **not** to do it for them.
- To contact the class teacher if they feel that their child might be struggling with homework or experiencing difficulties.
