### Cúrsaí Scoile

Agus an séasúr “filleadh ar scoil” thart orainn ba mhaith linn a mheabhrú do gach ball de phobal na scoile gur féidir éidí scoile a cheannach ó Grants Uniforms ar líne <https://grantsclothing.ie/> agus sa siopa.

Is féidir gach polasaí scoile a fheiceáil ar shuíomh idirlín na scoile [www.gaelscoilnamara.ie](http://www.gaelscoilnamara.ie) Meabhraímid do chách ár bpolasaí lóin sláintiúil, a deir nár cheart go mbeadh aon mhilseáin/brioscaí/criospaí srl ag na páistí ina mboscaí lóin ó lá go lá. .

Molaimid go n-ullmhaíonn gach teaghlach na páistí go cuí chun a gcuid málaí scoile/boscaí lóin/cótaí a láimhseáil, a oscailt/a dhúnadh don bhliain atá romhainn. Agus iarrfaimid ar chuide tuismitheoir cinntiú go bhfuil ainm do pháiste curtha go soiléir ar gheansaí scoile do pháiste.

*As “back to school” season is upon us we would like to remind all members of the school community that school uniforms can be purchased from Grants Uniforms online <https://grantsclothing.ie/> and in store. All school policies can be viewed on our school website [www.gaelscoilnamara.ie](http://www.gaelscoilnamara.ie) We remind everyone of our healthy eating policy, which states the children should not have any sweets/biscuits/crisps et cetera in their lunchboxes on a day-to-day basis. We would suggest that every family prepares the children adequately for handling, opening/closing their own school bags/lunchboxes/coats for the coming year. And request that every school jumper is clearly tagged with your child’s name.*

Leis an scéim leabhar cíosa, ní gá do theaghlaigh aon leabhar scoile nó cóipleabhair a cheannach dá bpáistí. Ní chlúdaíonn an deontas a fhaighimid ón rialtas na costais go léir do scoil nua, áfach. Iarraimid go gcuirfeadh na páistí ó rang a haon ar aghaidh a gcuid stáiseanóireacht féin ar fáil. Ciallaíonn sé seo cás peann luaidhe, pinn luaidhe, biorthóir, siosúr, scriosán agus roinnt dathanna, ar mian leis na leaná iad féin a bheith acu de ghnáth ar aon nós. Déanfaimid soláthar, ar ndóigh, d’aon duine nach bhfuil a leithéid de stáiseanóireacht dá gcuid féin acu. Ní gá do naíonáin shóisearacha ná do naíonáin shinsearach aon stáiseanóireacht a thabhairt chun na scoile. Cuirfidh an scoil pinn luaidhe, criáin agus gach stáiseanóireacht eile ar fáil. Comh maith le sin iarrfaimid ar chuide pháiste ó R1 ar aghaidh mála níoacháin a thabhairt leo ar scoil. Istigh anseo bíodh éadach beag chun lámha a thriomiú théis an leithreas a úsáid. Tá seo mar chuid den obair atá ar bun againn leis an gCoiste Glas scoile, chun úsáid agus costaisí páipéar láimhe a laghdú sa scoil.

*With the application of the book rental scheme, families do not need to buy any school books or copybooks for their children. However, the grant we receive from the government does not cover all the costs for a new school. We ask that the children from First class onwards provide their own stationery. This means a pencil case, pencils, a sharpener, scissors, an eraser and some colours, which the children themselves usually want to have anyway. We will, of course, provide for anyone who does not have such stationery of their own. Junior and Senior infants do not need to bring any stationery to school. The school will provide pencils, crayons and all other stationery. We also ask all children from R1 onwards to bring a small wash bag to school. Inside this is a small cloth to dry your hands after using the toilet. This is part of the work we are doing with the Green School Committee, to reduce the use and cost of hand towels in the school.*

**Mar a dúradh cheana, tá costais ‘tús na bliana’ ar scoileanna nuafhorbartha an-ard agus gan mórán tacaíochta ón Rialtas. Iarraimid go n-íocann gach paiste íocaíocht aonuaire chun cabhrú leis an iliomad costais a chlúdú. Seolfaidh Abina nasc tríd Aladdin don bhille scoile de €65 an páiste, a chlúdóidh soláthairtí ealaíon agus ceardaíochta, trealamh Aistir, trealamh matamaitice, costais fótachóipeála agus polasaí árachais do gach leanbh a chlúdaíonn iad 24 uair sa lá, ar agus lasmuigh den scoil. Iarraimid go cineálta go ndéanfaí an íocaíocht aonuaire seo roimh Mhí Dheireadh Fómhair, ach tuigimid an brú airgeadais ar theaghlaigh ag an am seo den bhliain..agus i gcónaí. Má tá fadhb ann ná bíodh drogall ort teagmháil a dhéanamh leis an oifig agus is féidir linn tacaíochtaí a chur ar fáil. Gabhaimid buíochas libh go léir as bhur bhflaithiúlacht agus tacaíocht airgeadais leanúnach le 5 bliana anuas.**

*As stated previously, the ‘beginning of year’ costs on newly developing schools are substantial and massively underfunded by the Government. We do request that every child pays a one off payment to help cover the costs of the myriad of expenses. Abina will send on a link through Aladdin for the school bill of €65 per child, covering arts & crafts supplies, Aistear equipment, maths manipulatives, photocopying costs and an insurance policy for each child which covers them 24hrs a day, on and off school premises. We kindly request that this one-off payment is made before October, however we understand the financial strains on families at this time of year..and constantly. If there is an issue please do not hesitate to contact the office and we can put supports in place. We thank you all for your ongoing generosity and financial support over the past 5 years.*

A quick reminder that the school car park is for staff cars and those families with accessibility needs only. We ask that you use the community centre car park if you are using a car.*

Tá obair na gcapall déanta ag Cairde na Scoile ar an bhfeachtas Siúl/Rothaíocht ar scoil agus taimid ag súil go leanfaidh muintir Ghaelscoil na Mara ag tacú le seo. Táimid théis eolas a fháil ón gComhlaire Contae go mbeidh córas aontreo i bhfeidhim i gceantar na scoile mar chuid do Sheachtain Soghluaisteachta na hEorpa. Beidh an córas seo in úsáid ón ón Máirt an 16 Meán Fómhair 2025 go dtí an Luan an 22 Meán Fómhair 2025 (agus an dá lá sin san áireamh). Tá tuilleadh eolais faoi iamh, maidir le treoir srl. Is rud dearfach é seo chun méid na trachta ar bhóithrí na scoile a laghdú. Is fiú dúinn ar fad ag smaoineamh faoi conas gur féidir linn ar fad tacú leis an bhfeachtas seo agus méid na gcarranna ar ár mbóithrí scoile a laghdú sa todhchaí comh maith.

*Cairde na Scoile have worked so hard to encourage all our students to become more aware and confident when choosing to walk or cycle to school. **Mar a chuala sibh sna nuachtáin le déanaí, d'fhógair Feidhmeannach Roinn Oideachais Fórsa go dtosódh stailc gan teorainn ag rúnaithe agus cúramóirí scoile Dé Céadaoin, an 28 Lúnasa 2025, an chéad lá den bhliain scoile nua.**

**Beidh ár rúnaí scoile féin, Abina, ag glacadh páirte sa ghníomhaíocht thionsclaíoch seo, agus ba mhaith linn a shoiléiriú go dtacaímid go hiomlán lena cinneadh. I scoil atá ag forbairt mar ár scoil féin, tá ról Abina ríthábhachtach. Ní hamháin go gcomhlíonann sí a dualgais féin le dúthracht eisceachtúil, ach i scoil ina bhfuil an príomhoide ag múineadh freisin, glacann sí go leor freagrachtaí breise nach féidir a dhéanamh agus an príomhoide sa rang. Gan í, bíonn oibríochtaí laethúla riachtanacha thar a bheith dúshlánach go tapa. Go simplí, is roth ríthábhachtach í Abina i roth ár scoile agus gan í, bheadh cur isteach suntasach ann.**

**Tá treoir eisithe ag ceardchumann na múinteoirí ag rá, cé go mbeidh múinteoirí agus Cúntóirí Riachtanais Breise ag dul thar an líne picéad chun filleadh ar scoil a chinntiú do na páistí, nach nglacfaidh aon mhúinteoir ná Cúntóir Speisialta Breise dualgais rúnaí na scoile le linn na stailce. Ciallaíonn sé seo:**

- Ní bheidh aon duine san oifig chun na fóin a fhreagairt
- Ní chuirfear aon teachtaireachtaí Aladdin chuig múinteoirí ranga le linn am teagaisc

**Iarraimid ar gach tuismitheoir/caomhnóir é seo a choinneáil i gcuimhne le linn na chéad laethanta gnóthacha sin ar ais. Déanfaidh bhur bhfoighne agus bhur dtuiscint difríocht mhór agus muid ag déileáil leis na hathruithe sealadacha seo.**

**Seasann muid le Abina sa ghníomh seo agus tá súil againn go ndéanfaidh pobal ár scoile an rud céanna.**

*As you may have heard in recent news, Fórsa's Education Divisional Executive has announced that an indefinite strike by school secretaries and caretakers will commence on Wednesday, 28th August 2025, the first day of the new school year.*

*Our own school secretary, Abina, will be taking part in this industrial action, and we want to make it clear that we fully support her decision. In a developing school such as ours, Abina's role is absolutely vital. She not only carries out her own duties with exceptional dedication, but in a school where the principal is also teaching, she takes on many additional responsibilities that simply cannot be done while the principal is in class. Without her, essential day-to-day operations quickly become extremely challenging. Quite simply, Abina is a vital cog in the wheel of our school and without her, there would be significant disruption.*

*The teaching unions have issued a directive stating that, while teachers and SNAs will pass the picket line in order to ensure a smooth return to school for the children, no teacher or SNA will take on the duties of the school secretary during strike action. This means:*

- *No one will be in the office to answer the phones*
- *No Aladdin messages will be relayed to class teachers during teaching time*

*We ask that all parents/guardians keep this in mind during those first busy days back. Your patience and understanding will make a big difference as we adjust to these temporary changes.*

*We stand with Abina in this action and we hope our school community will do the same.*
