Our staff has almost doubled for the 2025–2026 academic year, something that is felt daily in the warm atmosphere of the staffroom and in the wide range of extra-curricular opportunities now available to our students.*

## Cúrsaí Scoile

Glacfaidh ár bpobal scoile ar fad páirt arís i mbliana inár tradisiúin álainn, Kris Kindle. Gheobhaidh gach páiste agus ball foirne ainm a Kris Kindle an tseachtain seo, agus beidh an cúram speisialta orthu cárta Nollag a chruthú don duine sin. I rith na laethanta deireanacha den téarma, beidh deis ag gach duine a gcárta a thabhairt dá Kris Kindle agus *Nollaig Shona* a ghuí orthu. Cabhraíonn an traidisiún simplí seo cineáltas na Nollag a scaipeadh le linn an Aidhbhéant. I rith mí na Nollag, bainfimid taitneamh as roinnt gníomhaíochtaí idir-ranga atá dírithe ar chairdeas a neartú agus cineáltas a chothú, tríd léitheoireacht beirte idir R3/4 agus N1, seisiúin súgartha idir ranganna, agus b'fhéidir fiú tráth na gceist Nollag leis naíonáin agus ranganna níos sine measctha le chéile. Mar is gnách, leanfaimid le chur chun cinn ár bpolasaí BÍ Cineálta agus cuirfimid leis an obair thábhachtach atá déanta againn ar chairdeas, caidrimh dhearfacha agus ar conas a bheith i do chara maith.

*Our whole school community will take part in our annual Kris Kindle tradition this December. Every child and staff member will receive the name of their Kris Kindle this week, and their special task will be to create a thoughtful Christmas card for that person. *Gaelscoil na Mara was closed on Friday, 28th November, to allow all staff members to take part in whole-school training in the new Child Safeguarding Procedures, as outlined by the Department of Education. [Child protection procedures in schools](#)*

*This training ensures that every adult working with the children daily is fully aware of the laws, responsibilities, and procedures involved in child protection and child safeguarding.*

Is cuid lárnach den chur i bhfeidhm ná go mbeadh gach ball foirne, gach páiste agus gach tuismitheoir ar an eolas cé hé an Duine Idirchaidreamh Ainmnithe (DIA) sa scoil. I nGaelscoil na Mara is í Orflaith an DIA agus muna bhfuil an DIA ar scoil, is í Sinéad an Leas-DIA. Tá dualgas dlíthiúil ar gach ball foirne aon imní atá acu a thuairisciú, go rúnda, don DIA nó an LDIA, a dhéanfaidh ansin cinneadh an bhfuil gá comhairle a lorg ó TUSLA nó tuairisc fhoirmiúil a dhéanamh. Ag gach cruinniú den Bhord Bainistíochta, caithfear go dleathach líon na n-uaireanta ar lorgaíodh comhairle ó TUSLA agus líon na dtuairiscí, más ann dóibh, a tugadh, a chur ar taifead. Tá Ráiteas um Chumhdach Leanaí na scoile ar crochadh i gcónaí ag príomhdhoras na hoifige,

**mar atá leagtha síos, agus tá sé ar fáil ar shuíomh gréasáin na scoile.**

*A key part of implementing these procedures is ensuring that every staff member, every child, and every parent knows who the Designated Liaison Person (DLP) is in the school. In Gaelscoil na Mara, the DLP is Orflaith, and in her absence, the Deputy DLP is Sinéad. All staff members are legally required to report any concerns, in confidence, to the DLP or DDLP, who will then decide whether to seek advice from TUSLA or to make a formal report for further investigation. At each Board of Management meeting, the school must legally state the number of times advice was sought from TUSLA and the number of reports, if any, that were made. The school's Child Safeguarding Statement is also displayed at all times at the main office door, as required, and is available on the school website.<https://gaelscoilnamara.ie/polasaithe/>*

**Is riail nua é go gcaithfear póstaer le grianghraf agus ról an DIA a chur ar taispeáint sa scoil chun go mbeidh sé soiléir do na páistí cé leis ar féidir leo labhairt go rúnda. *A new requirement is that a poster displaying the role and photograph of the DLP must be visible in the school so that children clearly know who they may speak to in confidence. We will design and discuss this poster with the children before Christmas, and it will be displayed at all entrance and exit points throughout the school. We would also like to highlight the challenges facing schools today regarding online activity that takes place in the home. We are fortunate to have a no-smartphone agreement in place for all pupils while they attend Gaelscoil na Mara, something of great importance to us. However, we continue to see many children having access to online content through tablets and other devices. There are countless reasons to stay vigilant about children's online activity, now and as they grow older. We are attaching recommended Webwise resources and strongly encourage all parents to watch them and to reflect on the benefits and risks of their family's screen use in the coming weeks. *This year, we applied for the DAA's funding through the Elevate 25 project. A huge thank you goes to Múinteoir Sinéad, who spent many long afternoons completing the detailed application form. Our proposal focused on enhancing the school's class libraries and reading materials, as well as developing a dedicated common room to serve as a school library. Our vision includes creating a library-style service where children can borrow books, join book clubs, and have a quiet space to relax away from busy classrooms.*

Mar chuid den tionscadal seo, táimid ag súil le tuismitheoirí agus Cairde na Scoile a bheith páirteach i seirbhís leabharlainne sheachtainiúil nó dhá-sheachtainiúil, agus táimid ag tnúth le himeachtaí eile a eagrú bunaithe ar scaoileadh leabhar nua, Lá Domhanda na Leabhar agus Aonach Leabhar bliantúil.**

We are genuinely excited about planning and developing our school library facilities over the next two years. As part of this project, we hope to involve parents and Cairde na Scoile in running a weekly or bi-weekly library service, and we look forward to organising events linked to book releases, World Book Day, and our annual Book Fair.*

Glanmore Foods will be installing an additional kitchen in the new year, and once this is in place we will be able to offer hot lunches daily. We will also have the option to provide cold lunches on days when classes are on school tours or outings. **Reminder: Orders for next week must be completed before 2pm on Thursday.** You can set up a recurring order so you don't have to enter it each week. However, we encourage families to try a variety of options over the coming weeks. If you feel your child may be hesitant to try new foods, you may wish to send additional items from home until they become more familiar with the lunches.*

*We expect that this new system will take time to settle in, and there may be a few hiccups along the way, thank you in advance for your patience as everyone adjusts!
