-Táimid ag tnúth le ceiliúradh a dhéanamh ar sheachtain na hEolaíochta an tseachtain seo chugainn ar scoil. Beidh go leor turgnaimh spráíúla agus foghlama teibí ar siúl sna seomraí ranga. Má tá suim ar leith ag aon pháiste san eolaíocht agus má tá turgnaimh, leabhair nó scéalta acu ar mhaith leo a roinnt lena rang, tugaimid cuireadh dóibh iad a thabhairt isteach ar scoil an tseachtain seo chugainn. Cuirfear eolais agus griangraif abhaile tríd Aladdin i rith na seachtaine seo.

We are looking forward to celebrating Science Week next week at school. There will be lots of fun experiments and abstract learning taking place in the classrooms. -Creid nó ná creid táimid faoi lán tseoil ag pleanáil do Nollaig 2025. Chuaigh sampla do chárta Nollag a dhear do pháiste abhaile roimh an bhriseadh. Ní mór do chuile duine cinntiú go bhfuil ainm do pháiste i gceart ar an gcárta, agus do ordú a chrochadh ar Aladdin roimh an 9ú Samhain, le bhur dtoil. Is tionscamh tiomsíú airgid don scoil iad na cártaí Nollag agus d'éirigh go hiontach leis an coincheap i mblianta eile.

-Ma tá spéis ag aon chlann na bliainiris Súgradh/Spraoui srl a cheannach, beidh ordú scoile á chur isteach againn go luath. Faoi láthair tá nasc e-payment ar Aladdin agus gheobhaidh tú an eolas ar fad ó Abina tríd an aip.

-Rinneamar cinneadh foirne ag an Nollaig anuraidh, nach mbeidh 'Seó na Nollag' a eagrú chuile bhliain as seo amach. Believe it or not we are busy planning for Christmas 2025. A sample of your child's designed Christmas card went home with them before the break. Everyone must ensure that your child's name is correct on the card, and your order processed through Aladdin before the 9th of November, please. The Christmas cards are a fundraising initiative for the school and have been very successful over the past two years.

If any families are interested in the Súgradh/Spraoui annual, we will be submitting a school order soon. There is currently an e-payment link on Aladdin and you will get all the information from Abina through the app.

We made a staff decision at Christmas last year that we would no longer be organising a 'Christmas Show' every year from now on. We certainly understand that it is something very special and we really enjoy it as adults. However, not every child enjoys the amount of practice and time that goes into preparing a show. Not every child enjoys standing in front of a crowd or the pressure it puts on classroom life beforehand. We agreed that a lot of essential learning time is set aside to prepare a

show and that it is adequate to do this every second year. Thank you all for your understanding on this matter. This year we have organised class trips and other special days for the children. Information and payment links will be sent out soon regarding these trips. We will keep the price as low as possible, we understand that families are under a lot of financial pressure, especially at this time of year.

We are really looking forward to the Christmas period in school and the magic that inevitably comes with it!

Rollú 25/26

-Bhí an fhuinneog iontrála don scoilbhliain seo chugainn ar oscailt i Mí Dheireadh Fómhair. Le 123 pháiste sa scoil i mbliana, tá an scoil ag dul ó neart go neart. Faoi láthair tá 7 rang againn sa scoil. 6 rang príomhsrutha agus rang uathachais amháin. Tá chuile rang sa scoil, seachas Rang a 1 agus Rang a 4 lán. Bíonn chuile rang sa scoil ag feidhmiú trí Ghaeilge agus tugtar tús áite do chlainne atá ag tógáil a gcuid páistí trí Ghaeilge, mar a dhéantar i chuile Ghaelscoil.

Le 7 n-áit tógtha ó siblíne sa scoil, fágann sin 70 páiste a chuir isteach ar 21 áit sa rang na gCrosóg Mhara 2026/27. Beidh áiteanna á ofráil ar spásanna sna scoileanna ar fad i nDomhnach Bat ar an lá céanna, sin Dé hAoine 21ú Samhain.

The admissions window for the next school year opened in October. With 123 children in the school this year, the school is going from strength to strength. We currently have 7 classes in the school. 6 mainstream classes and one autism class. Every class in the school, except for 1st and 4th class, is full. Every class in the school operates through the medium of Irish and priority is given to families who are raising their children through the medium of Irish, as is done in all Gaelscoileanna. With 7 places automatically taken through siblings in the school, that leaves 70 children who applied for 21 places in the 2026/27 Crosóg Mhara class. Places will be offered in all schools in the Donabate area on the same day, which is Friday 21st November.

Coiste Glas na Scoile

-Tá an Choiste Glas Scoile ag obair go tréan ar théama na bliana - Athchúrsáil agus Athúsáid. Beimid ag cur isteach ar ár gcéad bhrat glas scoile roimh an sprioc-dáta don 3ú Nollaig i mbliana. Níl aon dabht againn go mbronnfar an brat orainn mar scoil, leis an méid oibre atá déanta go dtí seo. Meabhrú go bhfuil an bosca bruscar buí sa charrchlós scoile mar chuid den fheachtas seo. Comh maith leis an gcaoi a dtógann chuile pháiste a mála níocháin ar scoil ó R1-R4. Tá seo théis ghearradh siar mór a dhéanamh ar an méid bruscar a chruthaíonn na páistí. Tá sé tábhachtach go mbíonn an mála níocháin ag na páistí agus go dtabharfaidh sibh moladh dóibh as ucht iad a úsáid ar scoil.

Tá boscaí bruscair speisialta eile do duilleoga amháin sa charrchlós d'éinne atá ag iarraidh málaí duilleoga a thabhairt ar scoil. Tá a fhios ag na páistí go mbíonn na duilleoga seo ag briseadh síos go cré théis tamaill agus is féidir linn an cré seo a úsáid i ngáirdín na scoile. Focal buíochais do Neil Mac Uidhir agus Cúntóir Theresa a bhíonn ag obair go tréan sa gháirdín le tacaíocht ó pháistí na scoile dár ndóigh!

The Green School Committee is working hard on this year's theme - Recycling and Reuse. We will be applying for our first green school flag before the deadline of December 3rd this year. We have no doubt that we will be awarded the flag as a school, with the amount of incredible work that has been undertaken so far. Reminder that the yellow bin in the school car park is part of this concept. As well as the way that every child takes their own wash bag to school from R1-R4. This is to make a big cut back on the amount of litter that the children create, through paper hand towels. It is important that the children have their wash bag every day and that they are encouraged and praised for using them at school.

In addition, there are special bins for leaves in the car park for anyone who wants to bring bags of leaves to school. The children know that these leaves break down into clay over time and we can use this clay in the school garden. A quick word of thanks to Neil Mac Uidhir and Cúntóir Theresa who work tirelessly in the garden with help of the school children of course!

Teicneolaíocht sa scoil

-Le bliain anuas, agus buíochas mór le tacaíocht agus flaithiúlacht ár dtuismitheoirí agus an phobail scoile, d'éirigh linn airgead a shábháil agus a chruinniú chun infheistíocht a dhéanamh i roinnt iPadanna breise don scoil. Táimid an-sásta a rá anois go bhfuil 18 iPad againn atá ar ár n-ardán scoile le húsáid do mhúineadh stáisiúin, obair thionscadail, agus réimsí foghlama eile. Tuigimid go maith go bhfuil imní ag go leor daoine faoi úsáid teicneolaíochta ag páistí. Aontaímíd leis na tuairimí sin, ní ceart do pháistí foghlaim ó scáileán, ach foghlaim trí scáileán nuair a úsáidtear é ar bhealach cuí agus cothrom. Cinntimid mar sin go n-úsáidtear an teicneolaíocht chun foghlaim a fheabhsú agus a thacú léi, seachas fáil réidh leis na modhanna traidisiúnta. Nuair a úsáidtear go stuama í, is féidir le teicneolaíocht deiseanna nua a oscailt don chruthaitheacht, don fhoghlaim neamhspleách agus don dúshlán pearsanta. Is uirlis luachmhar í freisin do pháistí a bhfuil dísléicse nó díscráfaí orthu.

De réir mar a théann ár bpobal scoile in aois, táimid ag tnúth le feiceáil conas a úsáidfídh na páistí na hIpadanna bhreise seo chun iniúchadh, comhoibriú agus foghlaim a dhoimhniú sna míonna agus blianta amach romhainn. Over the past year, thanks to the generosity and support of our parents and wider school community, we have been able to save and fundraise enough to invest in additional school iPads. We are delighted to share that we now have 18 iPads available on our school platform for station teaching, project work, and other areas of learning. We are very aware of the growing concerns around children's use of tablets and technology. As educators, we share many of these views, children should not learn from screens but rather learn through them when used in a purposeful and balanced way. Our approach ensures that technology is used to enhance and support learning, not replace traditional methods. When used thoughtfully, technology can open new opportunities for creativity, independent learning, and personal challenge. It can also be a powerful tool for children with learning differences such as dyslexia or dysgraphia.

As our school community continues to grow older, we are excited to see how the children will use these additional iPads to explore, collaborate, and deepen their learning in the months and years ahead. Many thanks to Abina who spent many a long afternoon charging, updating and putting covers on all of our new iPads!!
