As you are aware, all primary school pupils' schoolbooks, workbooks and copybooks will be provided by the school for the new school year under the Department of Education's Free Primary Schoolbooks Scheme.

Therefore, the list that will be sent home in respect of each pupil and payable to the school will now not include books or copybooks but will continue to include a list of necessary stationery requirements as well as requisites contributions towards: Photocopying, Art & Craft materials, IT & digital resources.

All schoolbooks belonging to the school which have been used by the pupils under the Book Rental Scheme as well as library books and other school materials have been collected. Parents are asked to ensure that children return all items which belong to the school. Please remember that children can reuse folders, etc... that are still of good quality.

School Requisites and School Appeal

Classroom Requisites	€65 / child
School Appeal	€35 / family

Classroom requisites will revert this year to a payment of €65 per child. We are grateful to the Department of Education for providing all school books free of charge again this year. However, some costs are not covered by this scheme, including art materials, photocopying, Aladdin Connect, and other curriculum licenses.

The school appeal is also essential, as grants do not fully cover costs like lighting, heating, cleaning, Insurance. School appeal is a payment that we ask for per family please. Our school appeal will revert to €35 per family

These payments will come out in September and can be made via Aladdin or in cash to your child's class teacher. Thank you for your continued support

Retain From Last Year:

Old art shirt /t-shirt in small bag

Folders you are Required to purchase:

- 1 A5 zipped mesh bag
- 1 A3 zipped mesh bag
- 1 A4 display book with 40 pockets
- 1 A4 mini whiteboard (solid one where you can write on both sides)

Stationery you are required to purchase:

- 1 pencil case
- 3 HB pencils
- 2 red pens
- 1 packet of twistables **no markers or gel pens**
- 2 white erasers
- 1 parer (one that collects parings)
- 1 30 cm ruler
- 3 labelled large pritt sticks
- 3 labelled thin black whiteboard markers

Books / Workbooks & Copies will be provided in school in September.

N.B. Names to be clearly marked on outside of all stationery and inside all clothing and bags. Please label the entire school uniform as mix-ups may occur.
