Willow Park teachers are the essential link between the chess coach and the students: they play the video lessons, distribute chess boards and exercise sheets. They communicate any questions, doubts that come up throughout the class. And as an added bonus they learn chess together with the pupils. They aren't required to have previous chess knowledge.

How is a class built up?

- video content 10-15 mins
- interactive exercises based on the learning material
- free playtime with each other 30-40 mins
- distribution of exercise sheets that could be completed in class or at home



"Chess isn't just a game. Learning chess is a wonderful adventure. While getting familiar with the rules of the game, students get transported into a magical world where their imagination, creativity, logical thinking and strategic planning skills really start to develop. Chess, like other sports, teaches us about life too: how to get up after hardships, how to be a fair sportsman who will be respected by their opponents, how to follow through with an idea and make it into a plan.. Through the learning process, students begin to realise how much their chess knowledge can help them in all areas of life and learning.

The Chess program provides video content and practice exercise sheets aimed at 3 different levels, involving fun interactive lessons. All content is presented by Rosie, a former Hungarian national chess champion and Willow Park's choice chess coach.

- -Beginner: the basics of chess and essential rules taught across 16 classes, which will lead the learner to be able to play complete games, with the additional knowledge of special rules.
- -Intermediate: we look in depth at the 3 phases of a chess game: opening-middle game-endgame. Each element involves learning tactical and positional opportunities. This course is built on the "beginners" prior knowledge.
- Advanced: we dive deeper into strategy and positional chess ideas, following the examples of grandmasters. Students will be introduced to famous chess players and their unique styles of playing, so that they can start recognising their own preferred method for executing a game.

The only requirement to participate in Chess classes is to be able to read and write the English alphabet and know numbers 1-10. Everybody is welcome and each 3 different level will be catered for. Creator of the course: Rosie Ignacz



Spanish is the world's second-most spoken native language after Mandarin Chinese; the world's fourth-most spoken language overall after English, Mandarin Chinese, and Hindustani (Hindi-Urdu); and the world's most widely spoken Romance language.

Studies have shown that people who are bilingual are better at tasks that require multi-tasking and attention focusing than monolinguals. Brain scans show they have more gray matter in the regions of their brain that are involved in executive function. The hypothesis is that the effort to constantly choose the right language at the right time provides a "mental gymnastics" for bilinguals which gives them extra practice in focusing their attention.

These benefits show up early - new research shows that even babies less than a year old who are exposed to multiple languages show different cognitive patterns in their brain compared to monolinguals. In fact, some researchers argue that the best way to have smarter kids is to expose them to multiple languages when they are young.

And once you've learned one foreign language, it gets easier to learn others. So if you want your children to master a foreign language starting as young as possible makes it easier.
