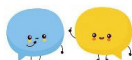

Spanish is the world's second-most spoken native language after Mandarin Chinese; the world's fourth-most spoken language overall after English, Mandarin Chinese, and Hindustani (Hindi-Urdu); and the world's most widely spoken Romance language.

Studies have shown that people who are bilingual are better at tasks that require multi-tasking and attention focusing than monolinguals. Brain scans show they have more gray matter in the regions of their brain that are involved in executive function. The hypothesis is that the effort to constantly choose the right language at the right time provides a "mental gymnastics" for bilinguals which gives them extra practice in focusing their attention.

These benefits show up early - new research shows that even babies less than a year old who are exposed to multiple languages show different cognitive patterns in their brain compared to monolinguals. In fact, some researchers argue that the best way to have smarter kids is to expose them to multiple languages when they are young.

And once you've learned one foreign language, it gets easier to learn others. So if you want your children to master a foreign language starting as young as possible makes it easier.

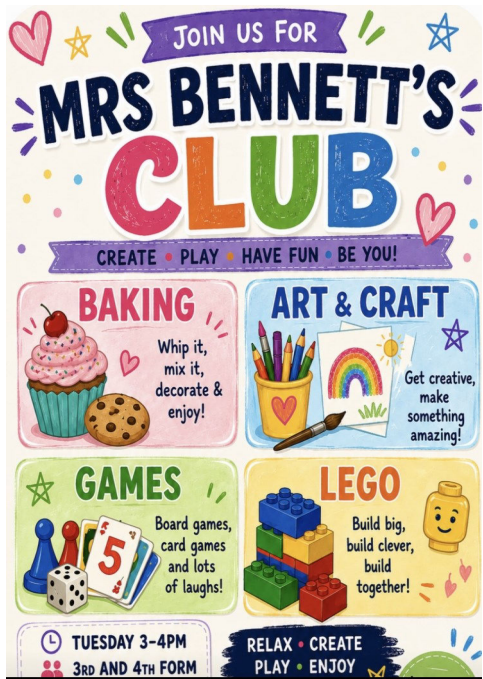

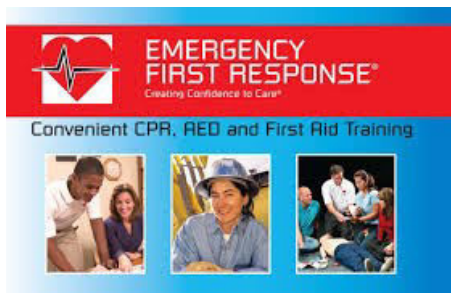

Willow Park Debating Society



Debating is the art of having a structured argument. The boys will learn how parliament debating is structured and the importance of proper etiquette when participating in a debate. They will also develop valuable skills such as public speaking, researching and cooperation.

There will be a debate every second week. A motion will be revealed and six boys will be selected to debate it. Three will argue in favour of the motion and three against. The following week will be a research session, in which the boys are permitted to make use of ICT resources to research the topic. Then, the week after, the boys will debate the motion. The purpose of the research session is to lighten the load for the boys, giving them a space to prepare without having to bring that preparation work home with them.

The boys are expected to prepare a three-minute speech that articulately and persuasively gets their points across. A timekeeper will be present to ensure that speeches are snappy and that the debate runs on time. Preparing and delivering a good speech is a crucial part of the process and where those aforementioned debating skills are sharpened.

The boys not delivering a speech on a given day will still be involved, as the floor will be opened up to everyone who wishes to share their point of view at the end of the debate. They will also be invited to assist boys speaking in the debate with their preparation during the research sessions.

After the winning team has been declared, a motion for the following week will be revealed and six new boys will be selected to debate it.
