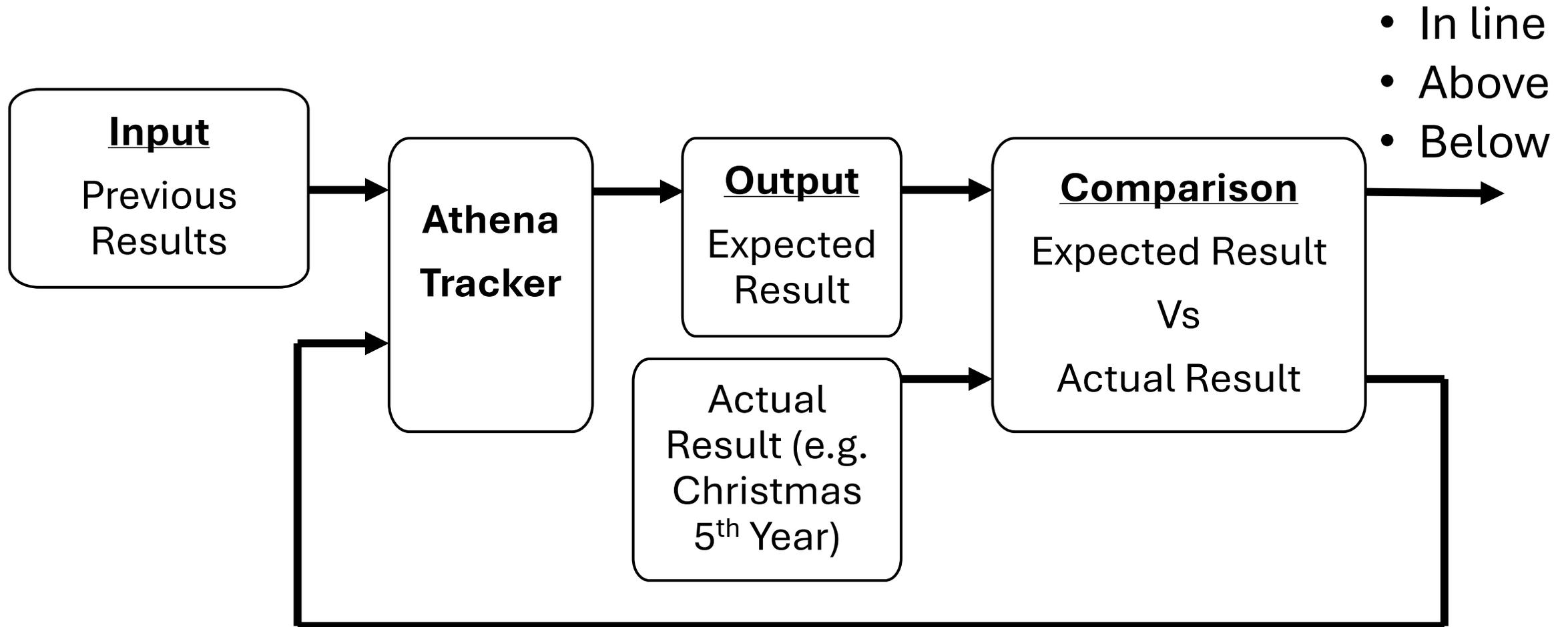
- www.athena-tracker.ie
- A tool for tracking a student's academic progress
- Are they exceeding / hitting / failing to meet targets?

How does it work?

- For each student / each exam / each subject
- Tracker produces an expected exam result (based on previous results)
- Compares actual exam result with expected exam result
- Indicates if a student is achieving potential or not

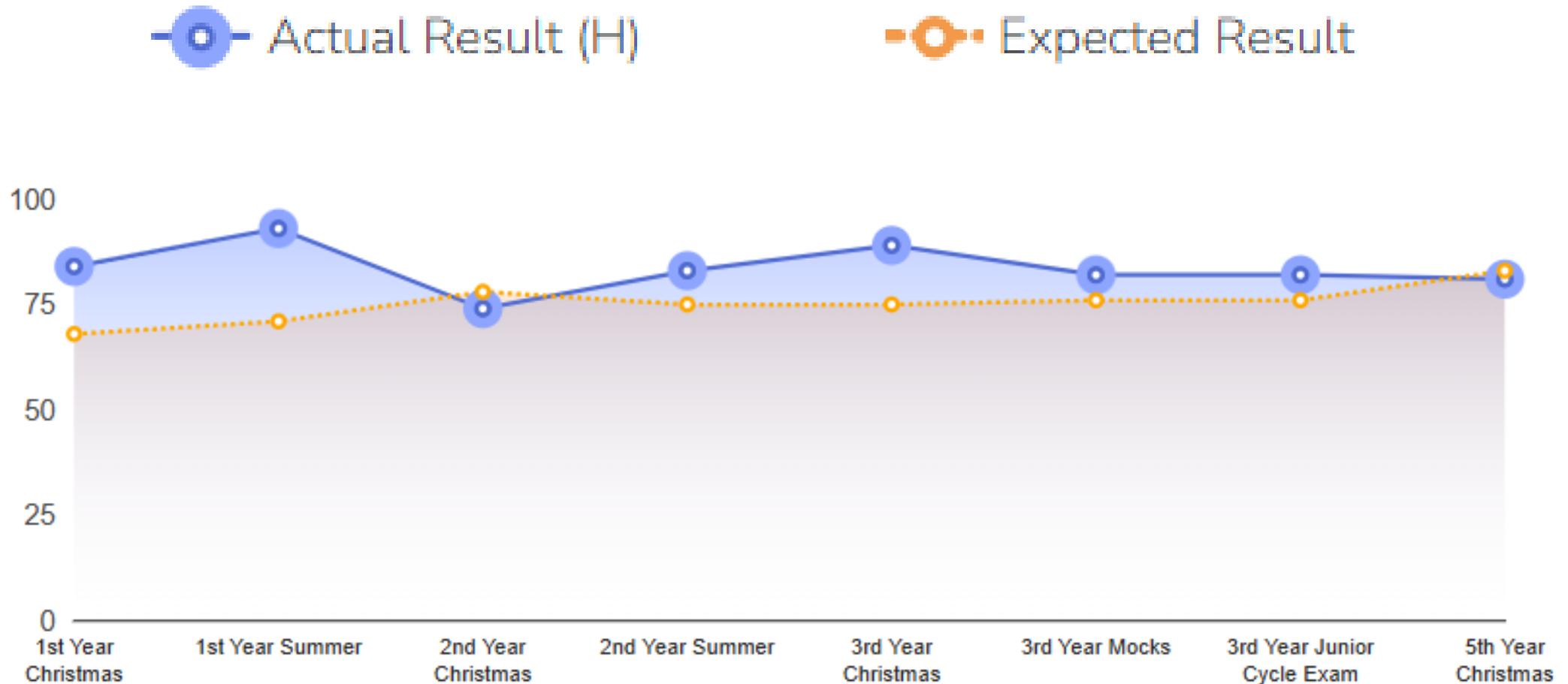
Rianaire Athena



- Software model is trained on over:
 - 18 million exam results + 350,000 students
 - Larger sample size → more accurate models (expected results)
- Used by over 400 schools in Ireland
- 2025/2026 – Introduced in Pobalscoil for 5th year students
- Introduced to staff since Christmas
- **Some staff may include it in Parent Teacher Meeting today**

Athena Tracker – Progress of Individual Student

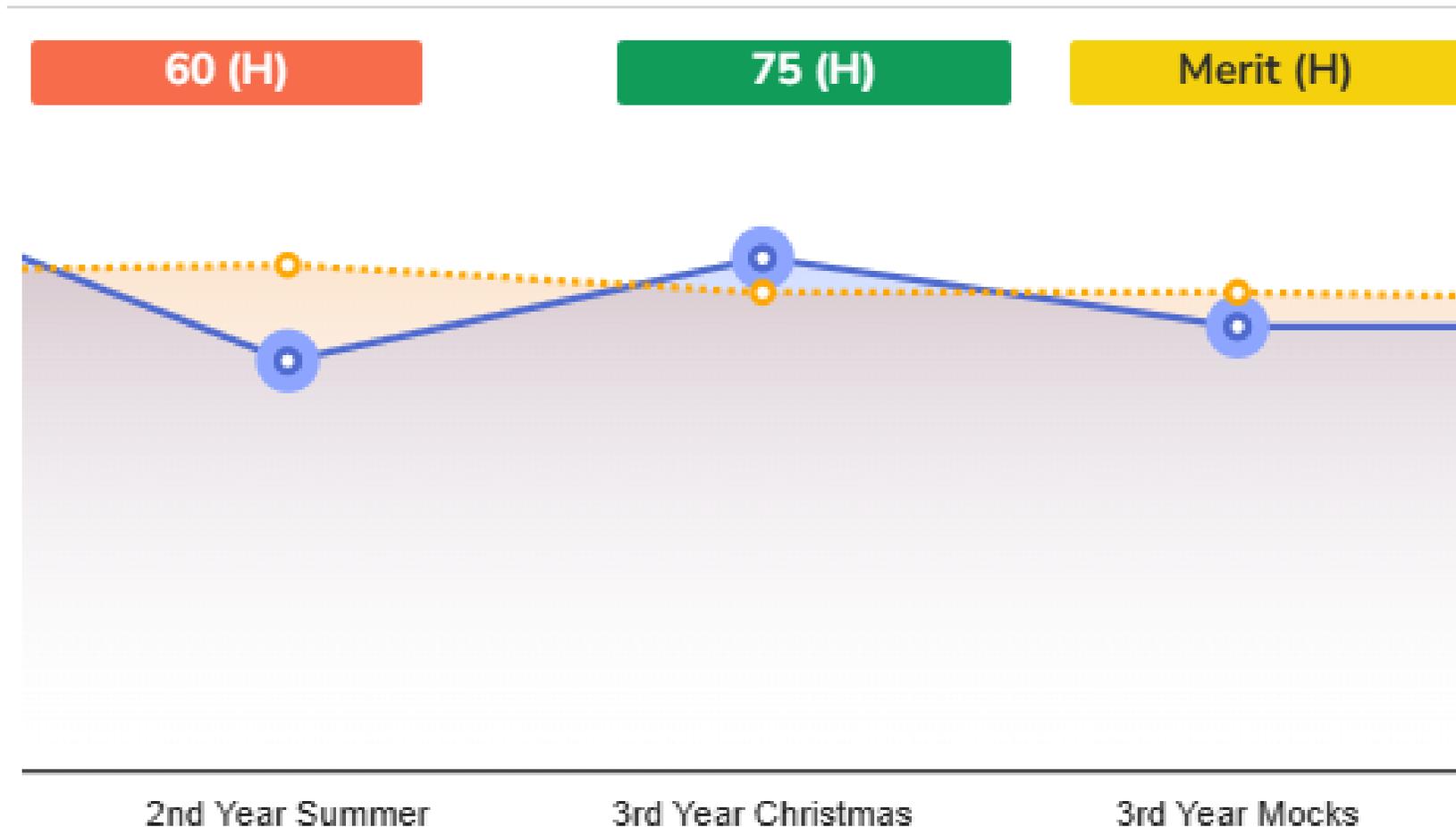
Rianaire Athena – Dul chun cinn an dalta



Colour Coding

Códú de Réir Dathanna

- Green: Above expected result
- Yellow: In line with expected result
- Orange: Below expected result



Remember ...

Cuimhnigh ...

- Recently introduced in Pobalscoil (staff and some subjects)
- Expected result is continually updated – not a “fixed target” (+ or -)
- The expected result is calculated **after** each exam and compared with actual result
- Not designed to provide a final Leaving Cert expected results

Remember ...

Cuimhnigh ...

- Athena output is only one other piece of information, along with:
 - Class average
 - Previous exam results
 - Results of previous students
 - Teacher's experience
- Does not provide reasons for performance (+ or -)
- Why not achieving expected result? Areas for improvement can be discussed at parent teacher meeting as usual
