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## Purpose of Report

In accordance with Ohio law and the requirements of the Ohio Department of Education and Workforce, school districts and public schools must provide **semi-annual written summaries of all reported incidents of harassment, intimidation, or bullying** to the Board of Education/Governing Authority.

- Monitor the effectiveness of school prevention efforts

- Maintain compliance with Ohio Revised Code 3313.666
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## Definition of Bullying

Under Ohio law, **Harassment, Intimidation, or Bullying** is defined as any intentional written, verbal, electronic, or physical act that a student has exhibited toward another student more than once and that:

- Causes mental or physical harm to the other student, and
  - Is sufficiently severe, persistent, or pervasive to create an intimidating, threatening, or abusive educational environment.

  - Administrative investigation procedures when allegations arise
  - Encouragement of student and parent reporting of concerns
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## Reporting Procedures

Students, staff, and parents are encouraged to report any suspected incidents of harassment, intimidation, or bullying to school administration. Reports may be made:

- In person to a teacher or administrator
- In writing
- Through parent communication with school leadership

All reports are **promptly reviewed and investigated according to school policy and state law**.

The administration will continue monitoring student conduct, promoting positive school culture, and responding immediately to any reports of harassment, intimidation, or bullying.
