For verification purposes, the letter of recommendation should include the full name, title, contact number and email address of the individual recommending the student.

4. CTI Application Form

Ensure all fields are complete.

5. Formal Acceptance Letter

From at least one accredited U.S. college, university, technical, or trade school for the scholarship award Year. Community College Students should submit copy of class schedule for verification.
