



Q&A With The Corp Of Engineers

Why doesn't the Corps remove the stumps sticking out at low water?

We remove or mark all stumps or other hazards located within marked navigational channels. During extreme low water conditions, thousands of small



trees, sand bars, and stumps are exposed, creating hazards for recreational boaters. The vast majority of these hazards are away from the marked channels. Our public safety programs remind users to exercise caution during these low water periods.

If boaters should find a hazard within the channel, notify the project office for the reservoir and the hazard will be checked as soon as possible. We cannot mark or remove all stumps exposed by unpredictable and constantly changing water conditions. What are the authorized purposes of the Corps' dam and reservoir projects?

U.S. Army Corps of Engineers projects on the Savannah River are "multi-purpose." These projects were authorized by Congress to support: water supply, water quality, hydropower production, flood risk management (originally called flood control), downstream navigation, recreation, and fish and wildlife management. During periods of severe drought, water supply and water quality are the Corps' foremost priorities, both in the reservoirs and downstream.

Clemson Development on Lake Hartwell Would Bring Apartments, Restaurants and More

The site of an old Holiday Inn hotel along Tiger Boulevard in Clemson could soon be home to restaurants, apartments and retail space. Clemson Dockside LP submitted a proposal this week to the Clemson planning commission for a planned development on a 5.1-acre site which has 450 feet of frontage along Lake Hartwell.

The proposal includes 322 residential units ranging from studios to five-bedroom apartments, 14,000 square feet of restaurant space, 8,000 square feet of retail, a six-story parking garage and a boardwalk along the lake. The property, across from the Hampton Inn hotel, has been vacant for more than a decade. "It is the gateway to the city coming off of the water," said Brent Little, the manager for Clemson Dockside LP. "Clemson is on the water, but there is not really a public place for everyone to go and enjoy that, so we are dedicating the vast majority of first-floor space to the public realm."

Little said his long-term plan is for the boardwalk on the property to connect with Abernathy Park, across from Keowee Trail. Julie Ibrahim, owner of The Tiger Sports Shop, has owned the property at 894 Tiger Boulevard since 2012. She said she is excited about how the development can open up what has been private property for residents to enjoy along the lake. She envisions people eating dinner along the dock with a patio view of "purple and orange sunsets." "I feel confident in what they have proposed,"



Ibrahim said of the development company, Fountain Residential Partners. "It is important to me that whatever goes in has my support as I've been a longtime resident of the city. I feel an obligation to put something there that will benefit all members of the Clemson community and the city itself."

Ibrahim said she has been working with Fountain Residential Partners for more than three months on the proposal. Little, who is the president of Fountain Residential Partners, said it is an \$80 million project. Over half of the units, 63.4%, would be studios, and one and two-bedroom units that Little said would target graduates, the local workforce and retirees. The remaining units would target students. Little estimates that single-bedroom units would start at a little more than \$1,000 a month in rent. The architectural firm Looney Ricks Kiss designed the look of the development, with inspiration from the Hotel del Coronado in San Diego, California, and Disney's Coronado Springs Resort, Little said. The project will be given a first review during the June 10 planning commission meeting at 6 p.m. The city has scheduled an informal public meeting on the project 4-6 p.m. June 11. Little's goal is to begin construction in the first quarter of 2020.

Ibrahim listed the land for \$7.9 million and is selling it to the developer. Ibrahim said the land is currently under contract as the development company goes through the planning process. Little said his firm has held and operated some developments for more than five years, but he said he is also open to selling the Clemson development in the future. "We are blessed in that our capital investors don't need to sell the property," he said. "If it makes sense to hold on to it, then we will do that."

The property is zoned in a community business, or "CP-2," district, where the maximum allowable building height is 40 feet or 65 feet for a hotel. The project is going through the planned development process because Little is requesting to build to 65 feet, city planner Art Holbrooks said by email. Planned developments require both planning commission and city council approval. Ibrahim hopes the development will remind people of the property's older days when it was a social gathering spot for the city.

Fishing Report


Lake Hartwell June 1st 79 degrees

Bass fishing is good. The top water bite is good early in the morning using the Pop R's and Chug Bugs to catch the bass still in the shallow water. Work the docks mid creeks and use the Lowrance Structure Scan technology to see the fish that are under the docks. Go to the plastics early concentrating on lay down trees and stumps. Be careful not to fish the plastic baits too early. Use the #5 and #7 pearl and shad colored Shad Raps and Rapala DT



10 shad crank baits. Use these baits on wind blown points and the rip rap. Carolina rigged green pumpkin lizards are catching nice spotted bass all day. Small chunk rock is the key while fishing the Carolina Rig. Use the Zoom Super Flukes in pearl and baby bass around rock and wood. Start off with the faster moving crank baits in the morning and then move to the slower moving plastics as they day heats up.

Play it Safe Around Water this Summer

Before you head out for a day on or near the water, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Savannah District encourages you to ensure you have life jackets for everyone and that you wear them.

Last year Savannah District recorded seven fatalities on the lakes it manages, including Hartwell, Richard B. Russell and J. Strom Thurmond. Five of the seven fatalities occurred in undesignated swimming areas.

In the last 10 years, 88 percent of all USACE public water-related fatalities were men and 68 percent were between the ages of 20 and 60, according to data compiled by the USACE National Operations Center for Water Safety.

The center also reports that 84 percent of all public water-related fatalities involved people not wearing life jackets and found that the greatest number of water-related fatalities involved people swimming in areas not designated for swimming. In addition, 27 percent of boating fatalities involved people falling overboard.



Several people who drown never intended to be in the water; they unexpectedly fell from a boat or dock into the water. When this happens, a person will reflexively gasp and can inhale up to one liter of water and drown in less than a minute.

Even a strong swimmer can drown from a fall into cold water because it causes an involuntary gasp (or torso) reflex. A life jacket can help save your life by allowing time for rescue. Some researchers consider cold water anything lower than normal body temperature of 98.6°F.

Others get into trouble swimming out to retrieve a boat that floated away, or swimming in association with a boat. Swimming in natural waters is not the same as swimming in a pool. Even strong swimmers can get into trouble and be gone within seconds.

It takes an average of 60 seconds for an adult to drown and just 20 seconds for a child to drown. Swimming ability also decreases with age.

Safety tips:

Swim at a designated swim beach. These areas have been inspected to provide a safe swimming environment. At all USACE beaches you swim at your own risk, so adults please watch your children because most people drowned within 10 feet of safety. Many shorelines at USACE lake and river projects have drop offs and you can be in water over your head instantly or pulled under by the current.
