Q&A With The Corp Of Engineers

Why doesn't the Corps remove the stumps sticking out at low water?

We remove or mark all stumps or other hazards located within marked navigational channels. During extreme low water conditions, thousands of small



trees, sand bars, and stumps are exposed, creating hazards for recreational boaters. The vast majority of these hazards are away from the marked channels. Our public safety programs remind users to exercise caution during these low water periods.

If boaters should find a hazard within the channel, notify the project office for the reservoir and the hazard will be checked as soon as possible. We cannot mark or remove all stumps exposed by unpredictable and constantly changing water conditions. What are the authorized purposes of the Corps' dam and reservoir projects?

U.S. Army Corps of Engineers projects on the Savannah River are "multi-purpose." These projects were authorized by Congress to support: water supply, water quality, hydropower production, flood risk management (originally called flood control), downstream navigation, recreation, and fish and wildlife management. During periods of severe drought, water supply and water quality are the Corps' foremost priorities, both in the reservoirs and downstream.

This is a safety issue, our permits, volunteers, police, ems, etc are only reserved for the above time restrictions.



MINIMUM AGE:

Entry in the Hartwell YMCA Olympic Triathlon is open to individuals 14 years of age or older.

TIMING SYSTEM:

The Hartwell YMCA Olympic Triathlon will be timed using the ChampionChip Timing System. (5 splits provided)

The swim takes place in Lake Hartwell. The course is 1500 meters clockwise with buoys being placed at 150-200 meter intervals.

Play it Safe Around Water this Summer

Before you head out for a day on or near the water, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Savannah District encourages you to ensure you have life jackets for everyone and that you wear them.

Last year Savannah District recorded seven fatalities on the lakes it manages, including Hartwell, Richard B. Russell and J. Strom Thurmond. Five of the seven fatalities occurred in undesignated swimming areas.

In the last 10 years, 88 percent of all USACE public water-related fatalities were men and 68 percent were between the ages of 20 and 60, according to data compiled by the USACE National Operations Center for Water Safety.

The center also reports that 84 percent of all public water-related fatalities involved people not wearing life jackets and found that the greatest number of water-related fatalities involved people swimming in areas not designated for swimming. In addition, 27 percent of boating fatalities involved people falling overboard.



Several people who drown never intended to be in the water; they unexpectedly fell from a boat or dock into the water. When this happens, a person will reflexively gasp and can inhale up to one liter of water and drown in less than a minute.

Even a strong swimmer can drown from a fall into cold water because it causes an involuntary gasp (or torso) reflex. A life jacket can help save your life by allowing time for rescue. Some researchers consider cold water anything lower than normal body temperature of 98.6°F.

Others get into trouble swimming out to retrieve a boat that floated away, or swimming in association with a boat. Swimming in natural waters is not the same as swimming in a pool. Even strong swimmers can get into trouble and be gone within seconds.

It takes an average of 60 seconds for an adult to drown and just 20 seconds for a child to drown. Swimming ability also decreases with age.

Safety tips:

Swim at a designated swim beach. These areas have been inspected to provide a safe swimming environment. At all USACE beaches you swim at your own risk, so adults please watch your children because most people drowned within 10 feet of safety. Many shorelines at USACE lake and river projects have drop offs and you can be in water over your head instantly or pulled under by the current.

Water depth depends on the spring rains, start will be 5-14 feet, and the rest of the course is 25-50 feet. Water temperature is expected to be in the low 80°F range. On-campus parking will be available. Please pay close attention to the parking attendants at the meet. Failure to comply with parking regulations will lead to ticketing by Clemson University Parking Services. Stadium seating is plentiful near the start and finish of the race. A grass area is available for tailgate type tent set-up. Spectators and swimmers are encouraged to bring chairs. There is additional viewing available on a dyke area along a portion of the course. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are 											
Rules:	present. Meet to be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming and SC Swimming Rules and Regulations and information herein. Important rules to highlight include: Toenails and fingernails will be checked before the race at the nail inspection area. If the nails are too long, they must be trimmed to a reasonable length at the discretion of the Referee. Wearing jewelry including watches is not allowed. No swimmer shall be allowed to use or wear any device that may be an aid to his/her speed, endurance, or buoyancy. Wet suits, flotation aids of any similar items, and anything used to maintain body heat is not allowed. Continual warm-ups will be available in an area near, but not on the course following general warm-up procedures.											
	Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms of locker rooms. Deck changes are prohibited. One event swimmers and non-SCLSC USA-Swimming members can only place and receive award(s) in the											
	open event(s). Swimmers in the SCLSC should register for and swim in the SCLSC Championship event in order to place and score points in that event. All swimmers can swim in additional open events. Athlete Eligibility:	For the general meet all swimmers and teams must be currently registered members of USA Swimming. For an additional \$15 fee, non-USA Swimming athletes may register for a USA Swimming One-Meet Membership. Onl SC LSC registered swimmers are eligible to compete in the State Championship events. Age will be based on the swimmers age on the first day of the meet.											

All races are out and back, swum along a buoyed line (kept to the right of the swimmers) that follows the east shore of Hartwell Lake. Buoys are placed every 100 meters along the course. Additional markers are placed at 50, 150 and 250 meters (half-K turn) to aid in the half-K. The finish shoot and line are clearly marked. At the 1K mark, the course makes a slight dog-leg left. At this point there is a set of two buoys forming a gate through which swimmers must pass on the out portion only of the 3K and 5K races. On the return portion, swimmers simply keep the course to their right.

Safety boats will monitor the entire course. Water and sports drink will be available on every boat on the course and at the turn. Swimmers must wear race cap, numbers on both arms and back for identification. Medical personnel will be on site.

For the 5K events, all swimmers who have not completed the course within 2½ hours will be retired. If the water/air temperature is above USA-Swimming's Rules the event will be shortened to a distance no longer than 4.5K.

Fishing Report


Lake Hartwell June 75 degrees

The fish are still in the recovery phase and feeding up. We have been focusing both in the Tugaloo River area and the main lake area where the Tugaloo and Seneca River meet. In the mornings we have been focusing on the top water and fluke bite. Our key baits for the top water bite have been a chug



bug or KVD splash and a poppin frog. The chug bug and KVD splash bait have been our multipurpose baits being able to fish them both shallow and over deeper water on Main River and main lake points. The poppin frog has been a good shallow bait for us and we have been focusing in pockets around the docks specially the walk ways where the bream have been hanging out. When the top water bite was slow we would break out the fluke and put it to work. Color depended on the whether or not it was cloudy or clear skies. If the bite slowed down we would switch to a shakey head in the same areas to help get some bites. We've gotten questions about guys having problems catching largemouth out on the main lake and only being able to find spotted bass. Two things to answer that right now, first focus on main lake pockets shallow a lot of these largemouth are still shallow recovering from the spawn this is also true on the points as well they will still be a little shallower than the spotted bass. Secondly those big largemouth will start to move out deeper and start really feeding up roaming with the bait and the spotted bass. The other key to this is that the largemouth will use the brush a little more than the spotted bass and wait for the bait to come to them so if you find brush in that 5 15 foot range spend some time working it with not only top water but a shakey head or a jig.
