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

# **Q&A With The Corp Of Engineers**

# If there is a problem with dissolved oxygen in the river, will you correct it with outflows from the reservoirs?

Our current outflows already help correct dissolved oxygen problems in the Savannah River although late summer quality remains a

problem. Because dissolved oxygen is less of problem in the cooler winter months, our drought plan now allows for reducing outflows down to 3,100 cubic feet per second for November through January when we reach drought level 3.

Before we deepen the Savannah Harbor we will install an oxygen injection system into the harbor to mitigate for additional loss of dissolved oxygen due to the harbor expansion. This injection system, in the form of Speece cones, will prevent the need to increase water flows to maintain current dissolved oxygen levels in the harbor.

## Isn't there sufficient storage capacity with all three reservoirs to reduce the winter drawdown from 4 feet to 2 feet?

Stakeholders often suggest the Corps should limit the amount of winter-draw down to 2 feet instead of four. They argue that when Thurmond Dam and Lake were built, a 4-foot winter drawdown was established to make room for excess runoff above Thurmond. But afterward Hartwell and Russell reservoirs were constructed upstream. These reservoirs provide more flood storage space because their collection capacity combines with Thurmond.

Indeed, with the construction of Hartwell and Russell there is more flood storage available in the basin. The question now becomes: is this additional storage capacity enough to decrease the amount we draw down the reservoirs in the winter? The answer may very well be 'yes,' but since so much has changed since 1954 we don't have enough data (yet) to answer that question definitively.

For example, we know human development, especially development of urban areas, changes the rainfallrunoff ratio. That is, in areas where porous soil is replaced with concrete roads, parking lots and buildings, less water soaks into the ground and more water fills the reservoirs. Cultivated lands, such as farm land also changes this ratio.

Another example of change since 1954 is the pendulum swing of the dry-wet periods. Although we are generally receiving about the same annual amount of precipitation from 60 years ago, the wet and dry swings tend to be more extreme. When rainfall intensity is high in short periods, greater amounts of flood storage may be necessary.

We need to examine these kinds of conditions before making the case to reallocate flood storage. Because of all the unknowns, the prudent approach is to assess current conditions and how they affect impacts of probable excessive rainfall.

For these reasons we have taken initiative to implement a flood-storage assessment that will provide the information needed to make an informed decision on the amount of winter drawdown required. We recently secured \$240,000 for this study. The assessment will provide data to help us reevaluate how much floodstorage is needed in the reservoirs. The study began October 2013 and we expect it to take about a year. Results of the assessment could demonstrate that less than 4 feet of drawdown is sufficient each winter; or it could confirm that a 4-foot drawdown (or perhaps more) is needed in the basin as it exists today.

## Challenge of the Centuries Offers Opportunity to Bike Ride Across Hartwell Dam

Held on Saturday and Sunday of Memorial Day weekend May 26-27, the Challenge of the Centuries is a 28 year old annual event. Rides of 35, 100K and 100 miles are held on Saturday and Sunday with riders leaving at 8 am each day from the Hartwell YMCA. Sponsored by the Hartwell Kiwanis Club the ride has annually 350 to 400 riders and each year has numerous riders who are repeat riders.

On Saturday the ride heads east with all three rides crossing the massive Hartwell Lake dam. Bikes are only permitted to cross the dam, about 2 miles, this one time each year. Each ride goes into South Carolina on gentle terrain of the Piedmont of North East Georgia. The rides on Saturday are: Smith-McGee Sojourn 39.7 miles, Ruckersville Ramble 67.3 miles, and Calhoun Falls Century 99.6 miles



On Sunday the ride heads west and north and is more challenging for the long rides. On Sunday you can do: Ridge View Venture 31.2 miles Pleasant Hill Ride 59.3 miles Assault on Dick's Hill 98.9 miles

A small processing fee is charged if you choose this method. It is the only method to register in advance using a credit or debit card. Sorry we don't take credit cards at the door. The 2018 Challenge of the Centuries bicycle ride registration is now open.

Family members are welcome to wait for their riders at the YMCA, where inside and outside camping is available, or to meet their riders at the various SAG stops along the routes. Also we expect to have the outdoor pool open in the afternoon after the Saturday ride. # **Fishing Report**


## Lake Hartwell May 1st 70 degrees

Bass fishing is good. Use a Zara Spook ad a Pop R top water bait and try to throw it as close to the bank or across a wide flat. With a steady retrieve, walk the dog and don't stop the bait for any reason. Some short strikes will occur but keep the bait moving. Follow up all short strikes with a green pumpkin lizard, a worm



and then a Zoom pearl Super Fluke. On the sides of the points, use a #5 Shad Rap or a jointed Shad Rap in the crawdad or green crawdad color. Use ten pound test line while cranking for best results. Any lay down trees that are near a creek channel needs a good working over as well. The crank baits cranked and then stopped right at the end of the tree will draw a strike if one is hiding in the tree. Many anglers are finding the bass way up in the rivers on small isolated trees and new flooded willow grass. If all else fails, use the Carolina rigged Zoom lizard and both small and large ones anywhere on the lake from the bank out to 15 feet deep. The bass will find it.

• **Concross Campground, Oconee County, South Carolina** Open May 1 – Sept. 30. The campground is conveniently located on the Seneca River near Townville, South Carolina, with a total of 106 sites, all with electric (30-amp & 50-amp) and water hook-ups. Shower/restroom facilities are conveniently located throughout the park. The following amenities are also available: dump stations, swim beaches, playgrounds, park attendant, and boat ramp with courtesy dock and security lighting.

#### • Paynes Creek Campground, Hart County,

**Georgia** Open May 1 – Sept. 30. The campground is located only minutes from Hartwell, Georgia, with 44 sites (37 waterfront). All sites are equipped with electric (30-amp & 50-amp) and water hook-ups. Other amenities at this campground include: shower/ restroom facilities, dump station, playgrounds, park attendant, 9-mile multi-purpose trail, and boat ramp with courtesy dock and security lighting.

#### • Georgia River Campground, Hart County,

**Georgia** Open May 1 - Sept. 30. The campground is located on the Savannah River just downstream from the Hartwell Dam, with 13 primitive campsites. Restroom facilities and fishing piers are available within the area.

- Elrod Ferry Day-Use Area, Hart County, Georgia

# Dragon Boat Races to Benefit Cancer Research

### May 5th starting 8am at Portman Marina on Lake Hartwell

The Dragon Boat Upstate Festival, now in its 12th year, has raised more than \$2.5 million in support of local families and hosts more than 1,200 visitors and team members during the annual event. Paddlers, volunteers and supporters enjoy a day at the lake while supporting cancer research and survivor-ship programs through the Cancer Institute at GHS.

It's easy to start a Dragon Boat team. All you have to do is pay the \$25 registration fee per person (fee increases to \$30 beginning on Thursday, April 5, 2018). Participants must be 16 years of age or older and your team must raise a minimum of \$3,500 to participate on race day.



The Dragon Boat Upstate Festival, now in its ninth year, has raised over \$1.3 million to date in support of local families and hosts more than 1,500 visitors and team members during the annual event. Paddlers, volunteers and supporters enjoy a day at the lake while supporting cancer research, rehabilitation programs through the Center for Integrative Oncology and Survivorship and other cancer services at the GHS Cancer Institute.

HOW DOES THE RACE WORK?

Twenty (20) paddlers and one (1) drummer all work together (along with a professional oarsman) to race on the waters of Lake Hartwell.

Each team can participate in a racing how-to seminar and one hour of practice time during the week of the festival. See the Captain's Information page for the Practice Week Schedule.

Each race is on a 220-meter straight course and will take about 2-3 minutes to complete the race.



Racing divisions will be determined from the combined times of the morning and afternoon races.

The teams will be ranked according to combined times and then grouped into three competitive divisions with an equal number of teams in each division.

The three fastest teams in each division will have the opportunity to race each other for their division championship.

In addition to crowning the festival champion, there will be winners in various categories.
