Background

- Educating youth for more than 100 years
- Evolved from a small schoolhouse to 15 campuses
- Educating nearly 9,000 students
  - More than 1,200 employees
  - Last bond election in 2015 for \$62.8 million passed with 70 percent approval

Enrollment Growth

- NBMS is near capacity
- Largest student enrollment growth was in 2017-2018 school year
- Grew by 1,500 students in past decade
- Projections show district will nearly double in size in next 10 years
- Projected student enrollment at build-out will be nearly 20,000

Age of Schools

46% are more than 55 years old



27% are 20-35 years old



27% are less than 10 years old



Bond Timeline

- January 2017 - Facility Planning Committee (FPC) begins meeting monthly
- February 12, 2018 - Facility Planning Committee recommends bond
- March 26, 2018 - Board calls \$106.7 million bond election for Nov. 6, 2018
- May 21, 2018 - Security Committee makes recommendations to board
- June 25, 2018 - Board amends bond order to total \$118,341,000
- October 9, 2018 - Last day to register to vote
- October 22, 2018 - First day of early voting
- November 2, 2018 - Last day of early voting
- November 6, 2018 - Election Day
