## Updates from the General Manager

### Water Usage

Many of our residents have received water usage violation notices from the City of Rio Vista during the past week. The Director of Public Works Robin Borre made it clear that every notice was the direct result of individuals calling the County's anonymous tip number and reporting what they felt were violations of the current water restrictions.

The city received hundreds of complaints from Trilogy through the tip line and was obligated to respond to each one. The notices that went out to our residents were purely "educational," which is why the blue slip that usually states the exact nature of the violation was intentionally left blank.

The Administrative Office has sent out courtesy notices to residents who are not in compliance with water usage restrictions. We have also notified the City of Rio Vista Public Works Department when there is an egregious occurrence, such as a water line break, and we are unable to notify the resident. Last month, there were a total of two such incidents. The HOA does not patrol specifically for water violations, but we appreciate the effort.

### 4th of July

The Fourth of July parade is usually the result of many months of planning. In lieu of a parade, management is currently planning a free concert on the Vista Patio for July 3 and Trilogy clubs performances for July 4. Stay tuned for more information.

## CalTrans Traffic Alert: I-5 Closure

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is continuing a series of weekend partial highway closures for the SAC 5 Corridor Enhancement Project beginning this weekend.

Work on southbound Interstate 5 will temporarily close the connector at the U.S. Highway 50 and I-5 interchange near downtown Sacramento for ongoing construction work. Detours will be in place, but Caltrans urges motorists to use State Route 99 as an alternate route to navigate around the closure and to plan for additional travel time.

Construction is set for **9 p.m. Friday, June 18 through 5 a.m. Monday, June 21.** (Around the clock work.) Southbound Sacramento I-5 and Highway 50 connector will be affected.

**Detour:** From WB US50 continue WB to South River Road (Exit 3) to turn onto EB US50 or continue WB to West Sacramento and take Harbor Blvd (Exit 1B) to turn onto EB US50.

**Detour:** From EB US50 motorists will take I-5 North-Redding (Exit 4a) to Richards Blvd (Exit 520) to turn around.

The work zone speed limit has been reduced to 55 mph and the California Highway Patrol will be present for traffic enforcement.

## Public Health Order Updated

This week, the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) released new state public health order that went into effect on June 15.

To help prevent the transmission of COVID-19, the new order requires all Californians to follow the state's current guidance for masking, mega events, K-12 schools, child care programs and providers, and the portions of current K-12 schools guidance that have been made explicitly applicable to day camps and other supervised youth activities.

The order replaces four previous state public health officer orders issued throughout the pandemic that were in effect through June 14.

Statewide COVID-19 Data as of This Week:

- California has 3,694,498 confirmed cases to date. Numbers may not represent true day-over-day change as reporting of test results can be delayed.
- There were 1,136 newly recorded confirmed cases Thursday.
- The 7-day positivity rate is 0.8%.
- There have been 67,321,874 tests conducted in California. This represents an increase of 179,633 during the prior 24-hour reporting period.
- There have been 62,593 COVID-19 deaths since the start of the pandemic.
- As of June 11, providers have reported administering a total of 39,306,368 vaccine doses statewide. The CDC reports that 47,066,170 doses have been delivered to entities within the state.

# EMERGENCY RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM



The Solano County Emergency Rental Assistance Program, known as "ERAP", provides help paying rent & utilities for income eligible renters living in Solano County who experienced financial hardship due to COVID19.

## WHO CAN APPLY?

**Renters** who live in Solano County, have experienced a financial hardship due to COVID-19 and who have a household income at or below 80% of the area median income.

**Landlords/Property Managers** of properties located in Solano County with tenants who are income-eligible and have experienced financial hardship due to COVID-19.

## WHAT HELP IS AVAILABLE?

**100% of Rent Arrears** for rent that has not been paid and is still owed during **April 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021**.

Up to 3 months of **Rental Assistance** for rent owed **after April 1, 2021** available to those with ongoing financial hardship due to COVID19.

**100% of Utilities Arrears** for PG&E, water, sewer and garbage that has not been paid and is still owed during **April 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021**

Up to 3 months of **Utilities Assistance** for PG&E, water, sewer and garbage **owed after April 1, 2021** for those with ongoing financial hardship due to COVID19.
