
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
Home sales were strong in January with 3,179 homes sold in the Greater Denver Metro area, a 6% as compared to last year and 45% more than just 5 years ago. Of the homes that sold in January, 2,273 were attached and 906 were condos/townhomes.

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# **Sold Prices**

The average sale price for a single family home saw an 8% year-over-year increase, reaching \$401,766. In January, the average price for a single family attached home increased 9% year over year to \$288,615. The average price of a condo/townhome was \$446,798, a year-over-year increase of 7%.




# **Supply & Demand**

January ended with 4,677 active listings of homes for sale in the Greater Denver Metro Area. Compared to just 5 years ago, there are one-fifth the number of homes on the market. At the same time, sales have steadily increased due to continued strong demand.

At the current sales pace, there are enough listings on the market to last 6 weeks.







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## **New Listings**

In January 3,804 new listings came on the market,53% more than December and 6% percent more than last year at this time. Still, the number of new homes that came on the market in January is 29% less than just 5 years ago as a result of fewer single family detached homes being listed for sale.


