Isn't the assignment clear enough?


Why don't students find their own errors?





#### #1 Overcorrecting

Perhaps the most common and dangerous mistake





### #2 Withholding Help

Some teachers might think, "It won't be 'fair' if I help too much."



### #3 Unclear Assignments

Children want to know exactly what is expected of them.



#### #4 Over-Expectation

The two causes of over-expectation are the problem of awkwardness and comparison based on age.

With practice, repetition, age, maturity, and time, most children will gain confidence and grow to produce work that is well-written, correct, and maybe even neat.
