- □ You should already have completed and submitted all Registered Level requirements. You can learn the details of that application process <u>here</u>.
- □ Begin fulfilling the requirements for Certified Level with the understanding that it might take two years and that your submissions are subject to approval.
- □ Generate a one- to two-page Course Overview **or multiple overviews** (see <u>sample</u>) for your class(es). Show dates, completion of IEW Units 1–9, stylistic techniques addressed, and other pertinent info.
- □ Collect six students' writing samples that obviously correspond to your Course Overview, **with stylistic techniques properly indicated** (students other than your own children):
  - □ from three different students, a high-, medium-, and low-level performing student from beginningof-class
  - and three more samples from (ideally) the same students from end-of-class (six work samples in total that obviously correspond to your Course Overview, including at least one 5-paragraph Unit 8 essay or a Unit 9 critique of five paragraphs)
  - □ Show date and student's first name (students other than your own children).
- Teacher of only Level A (gr. 3–5): On your Course Overview(s), show dates, completion of IEW Units 1–6 and at least one 5-paragraph Unit 7 essay, stylistic techniques addressed, and other pertinent information.
- □ Teacher of only Level A (gr. 3–5): Collect students' writing samples that obviously correspond to your Course Overview(s), with stylistic techniques indicated
  - □ from three different students, a high-, medium-, and low-level performing student from beginningof-class
  - □ and three more samples from end-of-class (six writing samples in total that correspond to your Course Overview(s), including at least one 5-paragraph Unit 7 essay)
  - □ Show date and student's first name (students other than your own children).
- D Obtain two dated and signed letters of recommendation, one from a parent and one from a student.
