Offer a weekend workshop! Viewing the DVD instruction as a group creates excitement and

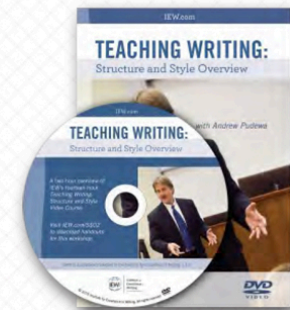
gives teachers time to answer questions posed by parents. Each family should obtain its own accompanying *Seminar Workbook*.

Structure and Style for Students

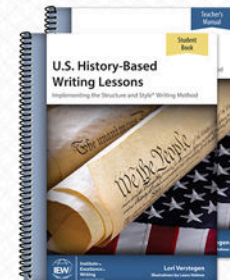
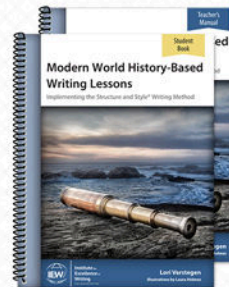
