IIFL Foundation Supports Establishment of Two Computer Labs in Udaipur Government Schools Benefiting Over 1200 Girl Students

IIFL Foundation today announced the establishment of two state-of-the art computer labs in partnership with the Rajasthan Government, at Kherwara Girls' Higher Secondary School and Kanabai Girls' Higher Secondary School in Udaipur district.

The initiative provides fifteen computers to each school, benefitting over 1200 girl students in Kherwara and Nayagaon blocks, areas with a majority indigenous tribal population. This is a part of IIFL Foundation's long-term partnership with the Education Department of Rajasthan, which aims to provide state-of-the-art classrooms, smart labs, and clean toilets, ensuring a conducive learning environment across 102 Girls' Schools.

Mrs. Madhu Jain, Director, IIFL Foundation said, "We at IIFL Foundation have been working towards creating opportunities for girl students by making advanced education methods and technology available even in the most interior places in Rajasthan. We are grateful to the Rajasthan Government and Education Department for providing us with this prospect of supporting school education system at such a scale.
