English Channel - England and France North Channel - Ireland and Scotland Bristol Channel - starting or finishing in North Devon England / Porthcawl, Wales

13 August 1972 - English Channel - 18 hours 11 minutes

11 August 1973 - North Channel - 18 hours 27 minutes

17 July 1975 - Bristol Channel - 14 hours 26 minutes
