10:15 – 10:30

Pilot observing tidal flow, water and wind conditions.

Swimmer had Starbucks coffee reported having ate a good breakfast and feeling well

Nil Medications taken prior to swim start

10:31 Photos taken

Swimmer in good form all feeds checked

All attire checked to meet IDLSA standards

10:45

Swimmer advised start in -5 mins

10:49

Swimmer entered the water a few meters away from start point

10:51

Whistle sounded and swim commenced

11:47

Swimmer passing Narrow Water Castle

11:59

Swimmer passing leading lights navigation markers

12:09

Pilot communication with harbour master for permission to pass the harbour

Swimmer passes SEATRUCK Performance moored at Warrenpoint docks

At feed swimmer asked for 2 x Solpadine same issued by crew

Swimmer passing Carlingford Marina

Swimmer advised at feed to increase stroke rate to get benefit of fast ebb of tide. Swimmers stroke rate up to 68 from 64

Buoy markers 16 RED 21 GREEN
Visibly fast water flow against markers.
Swimmer recorded swimming at 9KPH

15:15

Pilot in communications with Warrenpoint Harbour and Greencastle - Greenore Ferry.

15:19

Swimmer passing Greenore Harbour.

15:41

Swimmer passing Greencastle Harbour.
Lions mane visible.

16:05

Swimmer passing Haulbowline lighthouse.

16:32

Crew communications with swimmer via whiteboard 1mile to swim. Swimmer acknowledges with thumbs up.

16:40

Swimmers feed due at 16:56 decision by crew not to feed as finish line imminent.

16:48

Swimmer 10m from Hellyhunter Cardinal mark / finish point requests answer from crew: can I touch it? Crew Milo confirms yes.

16:49

Swimmer touches Hellyhunter Cardinal mark / finish point – Sea state permits swimmer to do so.

16:54

Swimmer onboard infinity rinsed, redressed, rewarming great condition, champagne in hand smiling and photos taken. Swimmer reports ‘a few jelly fish stings’ to left arm. No ill effect.

16:59

infinity taxi to Carlingford Marina.

17.23

Arrival and Carlingford Marina.

Swimmer in good form able to assist crew with disembark.

18:09

Crew photo with swimmer prior to departure.


