

Lauren O'Malley, USA swam Carlingford Lough, from Victoria Lock near Warrenpoint, Coordinates 54 07.583 N 006 18.330 W to the Helly Hunter Cardinal Marker Buoy near Haulbowline Light House, Coordinates 54 00.351 N 006 02.052 W in a time of 5 hrs 58 mins 18 secs on the 19th July 2020.

This swim has now been ratified by ILDSA.

The distance from point to point measures at 24.5 km and is recorded in the <u>ILDSA historical database</u>.


