

Poster Guidelines

Poster Presentation

- ❖ **Format and orientation:** All posters must be in **A0 format (841 × 1189 mm; 33.1 × 46.8 inches)** and **portrait layout**.
- ❖ **Title placement:** Position the poster title prominently at the top of the board using a font size of at least 72-point.
- ❖ **Presenting author:** Clearly identify the presenting author in the author list (e.g., by boldface, underlining, or an asterisk).
- ❖ **Design :** Ensure that text, figures, and graphics can be easily read from a distance of approximately 2 meters. Use clear, well-defined charts and illustrations, avoiding unnecessary detail.
- ❖ **Optional design template:** For inspiration, you may consult the *Better Scientific Poster* format available at <https://osf.io/ef53g/overview>. This format emphasizes visual clarity and accessibility by featuring the main finding at the center of the poster in plain language, designed to capture attention and foster engagement from a broad scientific audience. Adoption of this format is optional, but presenters are encouraged to apply its principles - clarity, focus, and accessibility - to promote discussion and visibility during the ICSPP poster sessions.

Poster Mounting

- ❖ **Display boards:** Posters will be displayed on grid panels.
- ❖ **Mounting materials:** Clips will be provided on site to attach posters to the panels. Presenters may bring additional materials if preferred, but this is not required.

Conflict of Interest

- ❖ All presenters must disclose relevant conflicts of interest. Industry authors must list their employer.
- ❖ Grant acknowledgements and any relevant copyright or trademark information must be included on the poster.
- ❖ Disclosures should be clearly visible (e.g., in a dedicated section).
