THAARAI VIDAL – OZHUKKU MARUTHUVAM – AN UNIQUE THERAPY OF SIDDHA SYSTEM

INTRODUCTION

It is in need of hour to collect and compile the details of all types of external therapies quoted in Siddha literatures for the development of Siddha Medicine worldwide. A lot of external therapies which are already mentioned in ancient Siddha literatures by Siddhars like Agathiyar. Some of them are still in daily use among the Tamil society like Patru, Vedhu and Varmam. Some of them are still not gain more attention in society. These therapies should be given more attention in treatment of various ailments by Siddha physicians. Some of such External therapies are

- Thapallam- mentioned for mental disorders
- Thuvalai- mentioned for psychiatric problems
- Puravalayam- mentioned for eye diseases etc.
- THAARAI mentioned for eye diseases etc.

Out of above listed therapies, this article provides some references in Siddha literature of Thaarai therapy.

Thaarai - An Introduction

Thaarai is a method of treatment is indicated in ancient Siddha literatures for treating several disease conditions like eye diseases, psychiatric problems etc.

Thaarai is a Tamil word which means flow of any liquid in a stream (continuous flow).

Meaning for the word Thaarai as mentioned in Tamil Dictionary (**T.V. Samba Sivam Pillai Agarathy**) are as follows

- xOq;F straight
- fz;kzp pupil of the eye
- NeNuhly; continuous flow
- fz;zpy; kUe;Je_iu tpl;Lf;nfhz;Nl, Uj;jy;- letting medicine continuously in eye in a stream.

The word **Ozhukku** which has the same meaning i.e flow in a thin stream is also used as an alternative word for Thaarai in Siddha literatures.

Thaarai or Ozhukku- applying liquid form of medicines in a continuous flow (stream)

 Mainly indicated for eye diseases in Siddha Literatures like Agathiyar Nayana Vithi 300 And Nagamuni Nayana Vithi 300.

Ennai Thuli Vidal- applying liquid form of medicines in drops.

• Mainly applied in nine holes of the human body (Nava Dhuvara) mainly in eyes, nostrils and ear.

Siddha literature reference for Thaarai technique

In Siddha literatures like *Agathiyar Nayana Vithi and Nagamuni Nayana Vithi*, Several eye medicines that are applied as *Thaarai* (continuous flow) are mentioned.

-Agathiyar Navanavithi

"Veepennai inth uppu mevunar seera moondru Nunnura kooti kondu narkathy kothi kothikka vaithu Onniratha thuniyi littu olukkida **thaarai** yaahiha Kannilida eluchy roham kadukave oodu kaane"
