INTRODUCTION

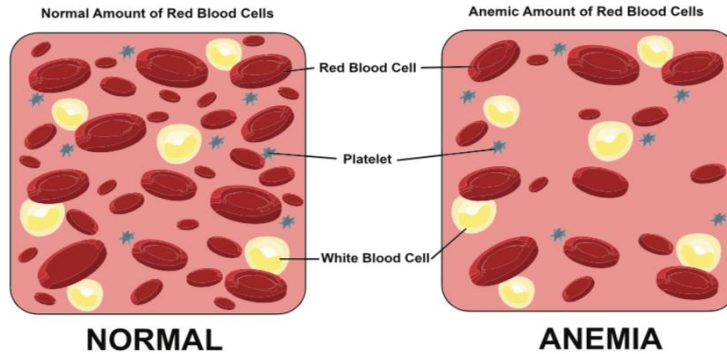
Anaemia remains one of the most prevalent health disorders worldwide, especially among women, children, adolescents, and economically weaker populations. According to global health estimates, iron deficiency

Community-based interventions create accessibility for underserved populations and encourage timely medical consultation.

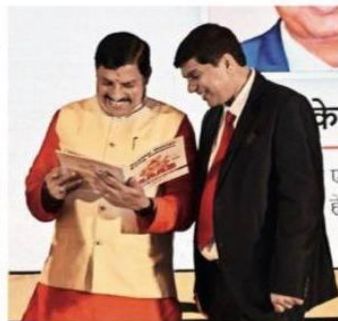
