Site inspected to confirm fallow and disinfection following positive BKD PCR result and clinical signs of disease (CDN2013007) onsite.

Equipment onsite previously has been removed and disinfected. Equipment in direct contact with fish has been disposed of. Nets and pens were disinfected in virkon baths and disposed of by Vonin and Northern Environmental Services, respectively.

Equipment not directly in contact with fish was also disinfected using 1% virkon. Some equipment has been disposed of/sent for recycling, while high value items, such as outboard motors have been placed in storage yards, following disinfection, for reuse.

Disinfection proceedure and records insepcted were comprhensive and well maintained.

New nets and pens have been purchased and are currently being installed onsite, although no equipment has been placed in the water.

It is hoped that the site will be operational by June 2025, however this deadline may be pushed back.
