Peaks in mortality 2024 wk 18 1021 ((1.11%), wk 19 743 (0.93%) CMS and seal predation. Wk 29 3504 (1.41%), wk 30 2673 (1.09%) seal predation and yersiniosis.

Peaks in mortality 2025, wk 5 1765 (0.91%), post treatment and CMS. Wk 38 1297 (0.49%), wk 39 1147 (0.44%) seal predation.

Mortalities for the last four weeks have been low with wk 44 301 (0.12%), wk 45 312 (0.12%), wk 46 342 (0.13%) and wk 47 258 (0.10%) seal predation.

Peaks in wrasse mortalities 2024 wk 43 361 (3.86%) no cause. No issues in 2025. No peaks in lumpfish mortality in the period checked. No lumpfish on site since wk 25 of 2025.

Wrasse mortalities for the last four weeks, 44 across the site.
