Additional Case Information:

Mortality and Treatment records were inspected remotely on the 26/02/2026. Movement, health surveillance and stock details were inspected on the day of inspection 02/03/2026.

Health report conducted by the business on 16/02/2026, summarised that site has been experiencing a fungal infection. The site have been conducting treatments weekly which has brought down mortalities. The stock and the fungal infection has been improving.

The fungal infection has been the main cause of mortalities on site. Fungus has been most prevalent in pens 25 to 31.

Site have been conducting bath treatments of cress and aquacen to treat fungal issues on a weekly basis, since the beginning of the 15/12/2025. Note mortalities have been low throughout this period and have been low in recent weeks.

The stock were observed to be shoaling deep in the water column with limited visibility. Stock did show good feed response during feeding. 9 moribund fish with fungus were observed across site but responded to stimuli. 1 mortality was observed across site.

60 fish were removed for VMD sampling. All fish were observed to be in good body condition. The fish had been feeding well as all fish were full of feed. Internally the fish were in good condition, but adhesions and melanisation from vaccination was observed.

Aquaculture animal and aquaculture animal product movement records were inspected and appeared to be adequately maintained.

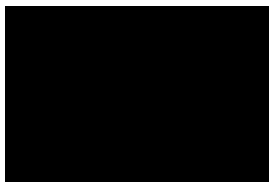
