Additional Case Information:

Mortality and Treatment records were inspected remotely on the 27/02/2026. Movement, health surveillance and stock details were inspected on the day of inspection 04/03/2026.

Cleaner fish mortality records were inspected remotely on the 27/02/2026. Elevated wrasse mortalities - 2025 wk36 7647 (10.10%), wk37 5384 (8.16%). Reason for these mortalities were due to freshwater treatments and handling events.

Elevated salmon mortalities - 2026 wk5 0.99% (5257), wk6 0.48% (2523), wk7 1.12%(4492) (this was reported to the FHI), wk8 0.34%(1329) these have been attributed to CMS.

Risk assessments SW to SW movements were available, they were checked and found to be satisfactory.

Fish health report conducted by business on 26/02/2026, summarised that overall fish are doing well. Some moribund fish had been seen hanging at the sides of the pens which has been attributed to AGD and CMS.

The stock were observed to be shoaling deep in the water column and were swimming well. Stock did show good feed response during feeding. 1 moribund/ lethargic per pen was observed with mild lesion that appeared to be healing well. 2 mortalities were observed across site.

2 fish were sampled for VMD. All fish were observed to be in good body condition. The fish had been feeding well as all fish were full of feed. Internally the fish were in good condition, but had adhesions that was attributed to vaccination.

Aquaculture animal and aquaculture animal product movement records were inspected and appeared to be adequately maintained.

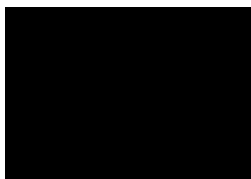
