Additional Case Information:

Site received ova from Iceland and from their own Native Hebridean stocks at Langass Hatchery. Both stocks are performing well. Very minor fungal infection has been observed in ~5-6 fish per tank and this is being monitored weekly and treatment administered as required.

2.3% (57,323) morts in wk17 2025 - deformaties (culls) native hebs

Fish in all the tank appeared in good physical condition, with the exception of tank 11 which had had some individuals with varying degrees of saprolegnia infection. This tank had received a formalin treatment on the day of inspection to address this.

Fish sampled for VMD appeared healthy both externally and internally and guts had food present.
