Additional Case Information:

Full inspection conducted on 07/04/2026. A movement of smolts had occurred less than 2 weeks prior to the inspection, meaning a follow up visit was required. No movements have occurred since.

Visibility at time of inspection was excellent, population demonstrated good shoaling behaviour and strong feed response. The main population appeared in good physical condition. Three lethargic fish were observed deeper in the water. A large quantity of zooplankton was observed in the pens, with the site reporting that this wasn't a common occurrence. It does not appear to be causing any issues with the stock at present.

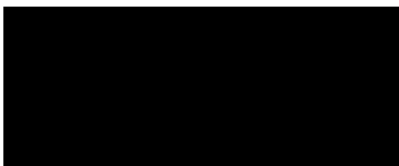
