POND DIPPING

Topic: Water - Things that live in the water

Activity: Learners get taken through the concept that water is required for life, but within it there is also life. Learners will then collect their own samples from our pond dipping area and then proceed to our outdoor classroom where they will explore the creepy crawlies in the water with hand lenses and with assisted microscope slides.



WATER PURIFICATION

Topic: Water - Recycling
Healthy environment - The importance of a clean environment, ways in which people pollute and the importance of recycling.

Activity: Learners will be taken to the Sustainability Classroom to learn how Intaka keeps its environment healthy. They will get to build their own sand filters with materials found on the island and put them to the test.



SILLY SEASONS

Topic: Seasons - The four seasons, how they affect us, plants and animals

Activity: Learners will be taken to an outdoor classroom where they will be shown how seasons occur through hands-on activities and group work. Learners will be divided into groups to sort different images according to the season they belong to.



HAPPY HOMES

Topic: Seasons - Animal homes

Activity: This activity will help learners to understand the different homes of the animals living on the island and the importance there of. Each learner will receive a list of animals that are found on the island and will then have to match the correct animal to its home.



SOIL SAMPLING

Topic: Different soils, creatures that live in the soil and the importance of soil

Activity: Learners will receive an introduction to soil, where it comes from, the make up and importance of it. Learners will collect samples of the different types found on the island and investigate all the properties found in the soil.
