ALIVE OR NOT

Topic: Living and non-living things

Activity: The requirements for something to be alive will be discussed with the learners. They will then be divided into smaller groups before they go out onto the island where each group will have to make a list of 20 things that can be found on the island. All the items will be put together and the groups will then compete to see who can sort them as being alive or not in the fastest time.



PLANT PARADISE

Topic: Plants – Basic structure, functions of parts, what they need to grow

Activity: Learners will get their hands dirty by collecting a sample of one of the plants that are found on Intaka Island. They will then, in groups, investigate and identify all the structures of the plant by means of microscopes. They will also learn more about the functions of the structures and what plants need in order to grow.



FUN WITH FOOD CHAINS

Topic: Energy and energy transfer – food chains and habitats

Activity: After a thorough introduction on where energy comes from, who transforms it and how it gets passed on, learners will investigate the food chains of Intaka Island. With the help of images, learners will search for all the plants and animals in their specific habitats and then build their own food chains.
