



INTAKA ISLAND SLEEPOVER



Intaka Island is the perfect little spot for a centrally located one night adventure under the stars! In the heart of Century City lies the 16 Ha conservation area, a working wetland rich in bird and plant life and a unique getaway for a small group seeking a special night out in nature.



Who can sleep over?

Small groups ranging from school classes and adventure clubs, to scouts and other organisations. A sleepover requires a minimum of 20 people and a maximum of 40. We do not accommodate private sleepovers – but we do host special sleepovers during the school holidays, so watch this space!

What does the sleepover entail?

You can choose from one of three packages:

Where do we sleep?

Groups will be based in our Energy Classroom during the day. This provides an exclusive space that is secure and provides a central location for meals/luggage etc. At night we set up camp in the Educational Lapa, thus no need for tents (but we have some available should you like one!), just your pillow, sleeping bag and a collection of campfire stories! The Lapa has its own Eco-Loo, but ample time is given before bedtime for a visit to the Eco Centre facilities. Shower facilities are also available at Century City Clubhouse, short walking distance from the Eco Centre.

How do I make booking?



- 1) Make sure you have read the Terms and Conditions below – as this contains important information for you and your event.

- 3) You will be issued with a quotation and completed booking form – please sign and return immediately and we will provisionally book the date for 7 days.
- 4) Hereafter you will be issued with an invoice and a 50% deposit is required to secure your booking.
- 5) Full payment is required 7 days prior to the event.

What happens if I need to cancel my booking?



Please notify the Administrator immediately and take note of the following:

- If you cancel 14 days before the event you will be refunded all payments received
- If the cancellation falls within 14 days of the event you will not be required to pay the full amount, but will forfeit the 50% deposit.
- If the cancellation takes place within 7 days of the event you will forfeit the entire amount.



The Nitty Gritty:




- Overall supervision and responsibility for children/learners lies with the event-coordinator at all times, except during designated activities where Intaka Island staff will take over.
- Notify us of any medical conditions that are relevant and ensure that relevant medication is brought with.
- All costs include:
 - Accommodation
 - Food
 - Mattress
 - Activities
- Learners will be required to wash their own dishes after meals and clean up after themselves on completion of activities etc – this forms part of the overall educational components of the sleepover.

Directions:

Take the Sable Rd Exit of the N1

Turn right at traffic lights and follow road over the N1, down past Rantaga Junction and around the bend until another set of traffic lights.

Straight over this set of traffic lights.

Straight over the next set of traffic lights.

Turn right at the third set of traffic lights and you will approach a traffic circle.

Exit right off the traffic circle.

Take your first left into Park Lane.

Follow Park lane until you reach parking lot (you will notice two large locomotives)

Walk over wooden bridge to the entrance of Intaka Island.
