About the Project

The Mother & Child Hospital in Umpling, Meghalaya, is planned as a 100-bed facility, with provisions to expand by an additional 100 beds on the same campus in the future. The hospital will specialize in Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Paediatrics, Neonatology, and IVF, along with other secondary care services, including General Medicine, General Surgery, Orthopaedics, ENT, Dental, Ophthalmology, Urology, and Critical Care. The commissioning will occur in phases, with approximately 60% of the beds being operational in the first phase and the remaining 40% in the second phase. The hospital will offer a variety of accommodation options, including deluxe rooms, private rooms, semi-private rooms, general wards, ICU, NICU, and emergency beds.

Specialty Configuration of the hospital

The hospital will offer a range of specialties, including Obstetrics & Gynaecology, IVF, Paediatrics, Neonatology, General Medicine, General Surgery, Orthopaedics, ENT, Dental, Ophthalmology, Urology, and Critical Care Medicine. It will feature six operating theatres: two for super specialties, two for general surgeries, one dedicated to gynaecology, and one for IVF procedures.

Present Status

The structural work is nearing completion, with the implementation of structural and services details (MEPF) currently in progress. Interior work has also commenced.
